Preamble

1. Affirming our belief in God, we still hold these truths to be self-evident: that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty, and the Pursuit of Happiness. Throughout the world, people dare to dream of freedom and opportunity. We unequivocally defend that dream. We strive to preserve the freedom given to us by God, implemented by our Founding Fathers, and embodied in the Constitution. We recognize that human nature is immutable. We further recognize that the traditional family is the strength of our nation. It is our solemn duty to protect innocent life and develop responsible citizens. We understand that our economic success depends upon free market principles. If we fail to maintain our sovereignty, we risk losing the freedom to live these ideals.

Principles

2. We, believe in this platform and expect our elected leaders to uphold these truths through acknowledgment and action. We believe in:
3. "The laws of nature and nature's God," and we support the strict adherence to the original language and intent of the Declaration of Independence and the Constitutions of the United States and of Florida.
4. The sanctity of innocent human life, created in the image of God, which should be equally protected from fertilization to natural death.
5. Preserving individual, *Floridian*, and American sovereignty and freedom.
6. Limiting government power to those items enumerated in the United States and Florida Constitutions.
7. Personal accountability and responsibility.
8. Self-sufficient families, founded on the traditional marriage of a natural man and a natural woman.
9. Having an educated population, with parents having the freedom of choice for the education of their children.
10. The inalienable right of all people to defend themselves and their property.
11. A free enterprise society unencumbered by government interference or subsidies.
12. Honoring all of those that serve and protect our freedom.

Freedom of Speech

13. We believe that If we don't have free speech then we will never have a free country. Free speech is our most sacred and fundamental right. We believe that If this fundamental right is allowed to perish, then the rest of our rights and liberties will topple just like dominos one by one. We believe that Deep State bureaucrats, Silicon Valley tyrants, left-wing activists, and the corporate news media have been conspiring to manipulate and silence the American People. They have collaborated to suppress vital information on everything from elections to public health. We believe the censorship cartel must be quickly dismantled and destroyed. We believe the following actionable steps are required to do this:
 - A) A new Republican president must sign an executive order banning any federal department or agency from colluding with any organization, business, or person, to censor, limit, categorize, or impede the lawful speech of American citizens. Federal money must be banned from being used

to label domestic speech as “mis-” or “dis-information”. We must identify and fire every federal bureaucrat who has engaged in domestic censorship—directly or indirectly—whether they are the Department of Homeland Security, the Department of Health and Human Services, the FBI, or the DOJ.

- B) A new Republican president must order the Department of Justice to investigate all parties involved in the new online censorship regime, and then aggressively prosecute any and all crimes identified. These include possible violations of federal civil rights law, campaign finance laws, federal election law, securities law, and anti-trust laws, the Hatch Act and a host of other potential criminal, civil, regulatory, and constitutional offenses. To assist in these efforts House Republicans must immediately now send preservation letters to the Biden administration, the Biden campaign, and every Silicon Valley tech giant, ordering them not to destroy evidence of censorship.
- C) A new Republican president must ask Congress to enact legislation revising Section 230 to get big online platforms out of censorship business. Prospectively digital platforms should only qualify for immunity protection under Section 230 if they meet high standards of neutrality, transparency, fairness, and non-discrimination. We must require these platforms to increase their efforts to take down unlawful content, such as child exploitation and promoting terrorism, while dramatically curtailing their power to arbitrarily restrict lawful speech.
- D) We must break up the entire toxic censorship industry that has arisen under the false guise of tackling so-called “mis-” and “dis-information.” The federal government should immediately stop funding all non-profits and academic programs that support this authoritarian project. If any U.S. university is discovered to have engaged in censorship activities or election interferences in the past—such as flagging social media content for removal [and] blacklisting—those universities should lose federal research dollars and federal student loan support for a period of five years at a minimum. We must also enact new laws laying out clear criminal penalties for federal bureaucrats who partner with private entities to do an end-run around the Constitution and deprive Americans of their First, Fourth, and Fifth Amendment rights which in essence deprives them of their vote. Furthermore, to confront the problems of major platforms being infiltrated by legions of former Deep Staters and intelligence officials, there should be a 7-year cooling-off period before any employee of the FBI, CIA, NSA, DNI, DHS, or DOD is allowed to take a job at a company possessing vast quantities of U.S. citizens user data.
- E) We believe that Congress and the Florida Legislature must immediately pass a digital Bill of Rights. This should include a right to digital due process whereby government officials must have a court order to take down online content and not just send information requests such as the FBI was sending to Twitter. Furthermore, when users of big online platforms have their content or accounts removed, throttled, shadow-banned, or otherwise restricted no matter what name they use, they must have the right to be informed that it’s happening, the right to a specific explanation of the reason why, and the right to a timely appeal. Finally all users over the age of 18 must have the right to opt-out of content moderation and curation entirely, and receive an unmanipulated stream of information if they so choose.

Constitutional Issues

Preservation of Constitution

- 14. Keep Oath to the Constitution: We call for all who swear the oath to support and maintain the limitations and clear meaning of the United States Constitution.
- 15. Preservation of our Constitutional Republic: We support our constitutional republican form of government as set forth in the US Constitution’s Bill of Rights and the Florida Constitution’s Declaration of Rights in Article 1.
- 16. Enforce the Constitution Article 4 Section 4: The sovereignty of Florida requires the protections afforded under Article 4, Section 4, of the Constitution, and any failing thereof authorizes the

Governor of this State or the Legislature to declare an invasion, which shall be met with the full force of this State. We believe the Governor must immediately use his powers as set forth in the Florida's Constitution in Article IV, Section 1d and stop the invasion of illegal aliens into Florida caused by the Biden Administration's Open Border Policies.

17. No Foreign Law: No foreign law, contract, or judgment arising from any foreign state whose laws violate fundamental constitutional rights shall be honored or enforced by any Florida court.
18. Judicial Overreach: All attempts by the judiciary to rule in areas not constitutionally granted to the judiciary, including abuses of the "commerce clause," the "general welfare clause," and the "supremacy clause," should be nullified. Any federal enforcement activities that do occur in Florida shall be conducted under the authority of the county sheriff (SCOTUS ruling in 1997 Mack and Printz v. US).
19. Limiting the Power of the Supreme Court: Judges don't define the roles of judges; Article 3, Section 2, defines the roles of judges. We support Congress's limiting the power of the Supreme Court by invoking Article 3, Section 2, Clause 2, by "legislating exceptions and creating regulations" to limit the cases for which the Supreme Court has jurisdiction.
20. Amendments to the US Constitution: We:
 - a. Support term limits of twelve years for federal offices.
 - b. Oppose "packing" (or enlarging) the United States Supreme Court and support the pending "Keep Nine Amendment" as filed in the United States Senate and the House of Representatives with bipartisan support.
 - c. Support repeal of the 16th Amendment (Federal Income Tax).
 - d. Support restoring state sovereignty with the repeal of the 17th Amendment of the United States Constitution and the appointment of United States Senators by the state legislatures.
 - e. Support a change to the 14th Amendment to eliminate "birth tourism" or anchor babies by granting citizenship only to those with at least one biological parent who is a US citizen.
 - f. Support a constitutional amendment making English the official language of the United States, and one of no more than two official languages of all US territories and other possessions.
21. Executive Orders: We generally oppose all executive orders, whether by a President, a Governor, or a local official, that go beyond administration of executive authority and have the effect of legislation. We call upon the Florida Legislature or Brevard County lawmakers to nullify such executive orders.
22. Limiting Overreaching State Government: We recognize that the sovereignty of this state and its citizenry has been imperiled and threatened by the ongoing overreach of state elected officials and agencies. We call for the restoration of our liberty by the following.
 - a. No form of government shall ever again implement mass lockdowns on the people, our businesses, or our churches.
 - b. We oppose funding or implementation of any form of contact tracing.
 - c. The State Constitution must be changed to require the Legislature come to session after a declared emergency lasting 30 days or more in five or more counties.
 - d. The Florida Governor shall no longer use executive orders to create public policy or law, and shall no longer have the power to close businesses or declare some as "essential" or "non-essential."
 - e. The Governor's authority during an emergency shall not be delegated.
23. Dereliction of Duty: The failure by a public official to discharge any duty shall be a violation of the terms of his or her oath of office, which shall constitute a crime, and upon conviction, this crime shall be punishable by a fine or imprisonment, depending on the nature of the offense. Any entity or person who acts under the color of federal or state law to deprive a Floridian of the rights or privileges insured by the federal and state constitutions shall be liable to the injured parties for redress, including monetary damages and injunctive relief, notwithstanding any preexisting immunities.

Convention of States

24. Article V Convention of States -- We fully support a Convention of States under Article V of the United States Constitution, restricted to proposing amendments that will impose fiscal restraints on the federal government, limit its power and jurisdiction, and impose term limits on its officials and members of Congress. A Convention of States can bring power back to the states and the people, where it belongs. Unelected bureaucrats in Washington, D.C. shouldn't be allowed to make sweeping decisions that impact millions of Americans. But right now, they do. It all boils down to one question: Who do you think should decide what's best for you and your family? We the People or the federal government? We would always support the American people every single time.

Citizen Rights

25. The Rights of a Sovereign People: We support the historic concept, established by our nation's founders, of limited civil government jurisdiction under the natural laws of God, and we oppose the concept that the state is sovereign over the affairs of men, the family, or the church. We believe that government properly exists by the consent of the governed and must be restrained from intruding into the freedoms of its citizens. The function of government is not to grant rights, but to protect the inalienable, God-given rights of life, liberty, property, and the pursuit of happiness of all, including the unborn.
26. Protecting Constitutional Rights Regarding Age: There should be a single age of majority upon which, when reached, all citizens will be guaranteed their rights, duties, and privileges.
27. National Popular Vote: The National Popular Vote Interstate Compact is a direct violation of Article 1, Section 10, and Article 2, Section 1, of the Constitution and shall be rejected by Florida and all its officials. We support the Electoral College.
28. Recall Elections: We support the right to recall our elected officials.
29. Habeas Corpus: Any federal suspension of the writ of habeas corpus against a Florida citizen shall be violative of the 10th Amendment, Florida sovereignty, sovereignty of the individual, and actionable by the state or the citizen.
30. Census: In accordance with the United States Constitution, we support an actual count of United States citizens, and we oppose Census Bureau estimates and the collection of all other data.
31. Parental Rights: The rights of parents are foundational to Western society and shall be respected, affirmed, and protected by the Florida Constitution and Florida Law. Furthermore, we believe it is imperative that the Florida Legislature pass a Parental Rights amendment to be added to the Florida Constitution in order to secure these rights for future generations. We call upon the Legislature to properly recognize and affirm the fundamental right of parents to make all decisions regarding the upbringing and control of their children in all aspects, especially with regard to any violations of the Florida education system. Any failure to recognize, protect, or honor these fundamental rights shall be actionable. No parent exercising any of these fundamental rights shall be prosecuted as domestic terrorists.
32. Prayer, Bible, and Ten Commandments in Schools: We support prayer, the Bible, and the Ten Commandments being returned to our schools, courthouses, and other government buildings.
33. The Right to Keep and Bear Arms: State and Federal Legislatures shall:
 - a. Repeal and/or nullify the National Firearms Act of 1934 and the Gun Control Act of 1968.
 - b. Nullify any gun laws that violate the 2nd Amendment or rights of due process.
 - c. Support national reciprocity for gun ownership rights.
 - d. Recognize the right of Florida Residents to legally carry a firearm without a permit. Carry in our view means concealed and open carry.
 - e. Ensure that any of the above legislation shall not be construed as impinging on private

property rights.

State Sovereignty

34. State Sovereignty: Pursuant to Article 1, Section 1, of the Florida Constitution, the federal government has impaired our right of local self-government. Therefore, federally mandated legislation that infringes upon the 10th Amendment rights of Florida shall be ignored, opposed, refused, and nullified. Florida retains the right to secede from the United States, and the Florida Legislature should be called upon to pass a referendum consistent thereto.
35. Equal Protection for the Preborn: We urge lawmakers to enact legislation to abolish abortion by immediately securing the right to life and equal protection of the laws to all preborn children from the moment of fertilization, because abortion violates the US Constitution by denying such persons the equal protection of the law.
36. Article 5 Convention of States: The Florida Legislature shall extend the call for a Convention of States to limit the power and jurisdiction of the federal government.

Business, Commerce & Transportation

Markets and Regulation

37. The Biden Administration's Regulatory Onslaught: We believe that our country, its businesses, and its citizens must be liberated from Biden's regulatory onslaught. To liberate us from this onslaught we believe the following steps must be taken immediately.
 - 1) Restore President Trump's successful executive order requiring that for everyone NEW regulation, two OLD regulations currently on the books must be eliminated.
 - 2) Implement a regulatory budget to place a hard cap on the costs of government regulation, ban bureaucrats from pursuing enforcement action on informal guidance alone, and will require all government regulations be posted publicly or be made null and void.
 - 3) Require that all federal agency regulatory guidance must be posted publicly in a central database, or else be rendered null and void. Doing this will effectively repeal a mountain of stealth regulations and threats that rogue bureaucrats have imposed without proper oversight.
 - 4) Enact a law to ban bureaucrats from taking any enforcement action based on informal guidance alone. For example, never again will bureaucrats be allowed to bully and pressure banks to choke off or financially de-platform politically disfavored industries.
 - 5) Bring all independent regulatory agencies, such as the FCC and the FTC, back under Presidential authority, as the Constitution demands. We must ensure that these agencies do not get to become a fourth branch of government, issuing rules and edicts all by themselves. Such agencies will be required that they submit any regulations they are considering for White House review.
 - 6) Establish requirements that every federal employee pass a new Civil Service test demonstrating an understanding of our Constitutional limited government. This will include command of due process rights, equal protection, Free Speech, religious liberty, federalism, the Fourth Amendment protections against unreasonable search and seizure and all other constitutional limits on federal power.
38. Saving the Auto Industry from Radical Green New Deal Policies: We believe the Biden Administration is waging war on the US auto industry and the combustion engine with a series of crippling mandates designed to force Americans into expensive electric cars. To combat this, we must do the following.
 - 1) Cancel Biden's April 2023 emission regulations for light, medium, and heavy-duty vehicles

that are projected to kill 117,000 auto manufacturing jobs.

- 2) End the Biden Administrations' CAFÉ fuel economy standards that is expected to cost the auto industry an estimated \$200 billion and raise the cost of vehicles by more than \$1,000.
- 3) Reverse the USMCA terms the Biden Administration recently agreed to which allows the reduction in amount of regional auto parts content in North America cars by up to 33% which directly benefits China and other foreign producers.
- 4) Immediately stop the flow of American tax dollars that are subsidizing Chinese electric vehicle battery companies through the Biden Administration's so called Inflation Reduction Act.
- 5) End the Biden Administration's war on American energy that is raising the price of gas by again achieving American energy independence, and energy dominance, which will rapidly reduce the price of energy through more domestic production.
- 6) Overcome and expedite the Biden Administration's delays in federal drilling permits and leases that are needed to unleash American oil and natural gas production.
- 7) Exit again the horrendously unfair Paris Climate Accords and oppose all of the radical left's efforts for a Green New Deal that are designed to shut down the development of America's energy resources.
- 8) Create a task force to identify every unnecessary federal regulation that is hampering the American auto industry and eliminate them immediately.
- 9) Restore the U.S. Strategic Petroleum Reserve that the Biden Administration wastefully drained.
- 10) Enact a national tariff policy to protect American Workers and stop the export of American wealth and Jobs.

39. Municipal Preemption: We encourage the Legislature to preempt local government efforts to interfere with the State's sovereignty over business, employees, and property rights. This includes but is not limited to burdensome regulations on short-term rentals, bags, sick leave, trees, and employee criminal screening. We support preemption of city ordinances that dictate sick leave policies to private businesses. This excludes the handling of emergency orders.
40. Licensing: We call upon the Florida Legislature to review all Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulations (DBPR), business/professional licensing programs, and associated licensing for the purpose of abolishing or removing as many as reasonably possible and repealing those laws, rules, and regulations.
41. Practice of Law: We support allowing any person to sit for the Florida State Bar Exam regardless of educational background, as long as criminal and ethical background requirements are met. We oppose mandatory State Bar membership for Florida lawyers. We favor restricting those who may file grievances in the legal disciplinary process of Florida to those who have standing. Further, we support sanctions for those who weaponize and politicize the legal disciplinary process of Florida.
42. Reduce Business Regulations: We believe that the following businesses shall be minimally regulated at all levels.

Federal Laws:

- a. Repeal Minimum Wage Law and Prevailing Wage laws.
- b. Repeal Dodd-Frank.
- c. Repeal Sarbanes-Oxley.
- d. Repeal The Lacey Act.

State Laws:

- a. Eliminate Blue laws.
- b. Allow auto manufacturers to sell directly to consumers.

- c. Business licensing.
- d. Professional licensing.
- e. Purchase of edible products from small farms.

Local Municipal Laws:

- a. Minimum wage laws.
- b. Blue laws.
- c. Mandatory sick/family leave.

- 43. Trade Agreements:** We support free trade as a necessary component of American capitalism and of the United States' influence in the world. But all trade agreements between the Federal Government and other nations shall strictly adhere to the US Constitution and require approval by 2/3 of the Senate.
- 44. Origin Labeling:** We urge that all food products entering the United States show not only the country of origin, but also the country that processed it and the country that packaged it.
- 45. Florida Resistance to the Great Reset:** Florida should continue to pass legislation needed to protect the citizens of Florida from corporate violation of their rights in the Great Reset/Environmental, Social, Governance (ESG) scheme as follows:
- a. Ban companies and corporations that attempt to suppress funding for Florida industries from doing business with the State of Florida and its subdivisions.
 - b. Make it illegal for banks and financial institutions operating in Florida to make lending decisions based on anything other than financial concerns. The model for such legislation shall be the Fair Access to Financial Services rule promulgated by President Trump's Office of the Comptroller of the Currency, which was immediately suspended by the current occupant of the White House.
 - c. Add penalties in Florida law for corporations operating in Florida that lead or participate in boycotts against Florida due to legislative action to protect the rights of Floridians to decline vaccination, protect the unborn, stop the teaching of Critical Race Theory in schools, compete in sports with only those of their own biological gender, or to protect children and juveniles against sexual organ mutilation and hormones and puberty blockers designed to fake transition from one gender to another.
 - d. Add explicit protections for the natural right of Floridians to keep and exchange and store their wealth in the mediums of exchange (including digital currency, gold and silver coin, bullion, cash, and scrip) of choice to the Florida Constitution Article 1. This will help stop global institutions and the Federal Government from forcing Floridians to use the financial services and currency dictated by them.
 - e. Consider the expansion or use of existing Florida anti-trust law to prohibit collusion between woke corporations to cancel/drive others out of business.

Retirement, Savings, Unions

- 46. Government Accountability:** We call upon the Florida Legislature to eliminate all special collective bargaining statutes for public employees and to hold all public servants accountable to taxpayers through existing civil statutes. We oppose any distribution of taxpayer dollars to unions.
- 47. Social Security Privatization:** We support privatization of the Social Security system.
- 48. Protect Medicare and Social Security:** We believe that Biden Administration's reckless spending has put Medicare and Social Security Programs at Risk. To protect Medicare and Social Security we must do the following.
- 1) Republicans must never vote to cut a single penny from Medicare or Social Security earned benefits to help pay for Biden's reckless spending sprees.
 - 2) Cut the billions in taxpayer dollars going to corrupt foreign countries.
 - 3) Cut the mass releases of illegal aliens that deplete our social safety net. This policy costs our

nation billions of dollars.

- 4) Cut the left-wing gender programs in our military.
- 5) Cut the billions spent on the Green new deal and climate extremism and all other forms of waste and fraud.
- 6) We must never cut the benefits our seniors worked for their entire lives.

- 49.** Protecting Americans from radical Leftist ESG Investments: We believe that investors of retirement plans must be required to put American Seniors First and bar investment companies from considering any factor other than what will maximize benefits for retirees. To accomplish this we must ban insidious “Environmental, Social, and Governance” (ESG) investments in order to protect Americans' hard-earned savings and investments from woke financial scams. Congress should pass legislation to keep politics away from America’s retirement accounts forever. These Bans should be legislated at both the Federal and State levels.
- 50.** Employee Stock Ownership Plans (ESOPs): We support maximum economic opportunity for all citizens and believe that legal limits on employee ownership of Florida firms by Employee Stock Ownership Plan (ESOP) trusts must be eliminated. We also believe that changes in ownership from private individuals to a majority ownership by an ESOP must not create a disadvantage when doing business with the State of Florida or political subdivisions of the State. We believe the State of Florida should encourage the creation of more ESOPs by making information easily available to businesses located in Florida.
- 51.** Unions: We support legislation requiring labor unions to obtain consent of the union member before that member’s dues can be used for political purposes. We oppose card check. Florida should prohibit governmental entities from collecting dues for labor unions through deductions from public employee paychecks. We also encourage the adoption of a National Right to Work Act.

Energy and Environment

- 52.** America Should be Energy Dominant: We believe America should be Energy Dominant. The Biden Administration Energy Policies have weakened America, created massive inflation, recklessly depleted strategic petroleum reserves by selling reserves to other countries, primarily benefited China at the expense of America and has hurt American families by destroying high paying jobs in the American energy sector.

We believe to make America great again we must continue the Keystone pipeline project now and remove all red tape that is leaving oil and natural gas projects stranded, including speeding up approval of the natural gas pipelines into the Marcellus Shale in Pennsylvania, West Virginia and New York.

Additionally, we must

- a. Withdraw immediately from the Paris Climate Accords.
- b. Eliminate every unnecessary regulation in the federal registry that hampers domestic production.
- c. Immediately issue approvals for all worthy energy infrastructure projects with a focus on maximum speed to bring prices down rapidly. We further believe we must put thousands of Americans to work building the power plants, pipelines, grids, ports, refineries, and shipping terminals of tomorrow.
- d. Stop the wave of frivolous litigation from environmental extremists that hold up critical energy development projects for years, increase project costs and discourage future development.
- e. Stop all the Biden Administration policies that distort energy markets, limit consumer choice and drive-up costs on consumers, including insane wind subsidies and DOE and EPA regulations that prevent Americans from buying incandescent lightbulbs, gas stoves, quality dishwashers and shower heads and so much more.
- f. Support nuclear energy production by modernizing the Nuclear Regulatory Commission,

working to keep existing power plants open and by investing in innovative small modular reactors.

- g. Modernize and harden the electric grid and ensure it has enough continuous base load production plants

- 53. Utilities:** We support free-market solutions for providing resilient and reliable utilities.
- 54. Power Grid:** We urge the Florida Legislature to pass legislation to harden the Florida Electric Grid increasing capacity and preparedness for all hazards, including:
- a. Cyberattacks on the grid's computerized command and control system.
 - b. Physical attacks on substations and major high-voltage transformers.
 - c. Geomagnetic storms created by solar flares from the sun.
 - d. Electromagnetic Pulse (EMP).
 - e. Extreme weather events, both cold and hot.
 - f. Making sure we do not have an overdependence on wind and solar power. Additionally, we believe that the Governor must issue a comprehensive annual report documenting that Florida will have enough Continuous Base Load production plants being added to the Florida Power Grid to insure Floridians have the power they need 24/7.
- 55. Carbon Tax:** We oppose all efforts to classify carbon dioxide as a pollutant.
- 56. Environment:** We oppose environmentalism that obstructs legitimate business interests and private property use, including the regulatory taking of property by governmental agencies. We oppose the abuse of the Endangered Species Act to confiscate and limit the use of personal property and to infringe on a property owner's livelihood. We support the defunding of "climate justice" initiatives, the abolition of the Environmental Protection Agency, and repeal of the Endangered Species Act, and we oppose the "America the Beautiful" Initiative, also known as the 30 x 30 program.
- 57. Flooding Mitigation, Hurricane, and Early Warning of Impending Disaster:** We support the immediate study, implementation, and construction of projects that will:
- a. Address river, reservoir, lake and other flood threats to public and private property.
 - b. Seek the input of those most likely to be affected by a casualty to public and private property, to include infrastructure and facilities that affect national security.
 - c. Address the risk of storm or tidal surge that affects critical industries along our coasts.
 - d. Create or improve existing early warning systems that will immediately alert residents to an impending flood, wind, or casualty weather event.
 - e. Provide funds to complete these projects from federal, state, and local funds.
 - f. Governments at all levels must work together to avoid the historical bent to push projects, safety, and implementation into the future. Projects must be of most urgent priority now to avoid further trauma; loss of life; loss of personal, government, and business wealth; and diminution of the tax base.
- 58. Tidelands and Resources:** We assert that the State of Florida and all coastal states shall enjoy and maintain jurisdiction and control of their offshore waters up to the international water boundaries, as well as state inland waterways, regarding all natural resources therein, and that the federal government shall not set limits on harvesting or taking natural resources therein, nor allow foreign entities to harvest or take such natural resources therein, including minerals, game, fisheries, and hydrocarbons. Also, we demand that no entity shall usurp Florida's original tideland boundaries.
- 59. Water Resources:** While we support individuals' rights to the groundwater under their property and their right to capture it, we support tying surface rights of ownership to groundwater rights of ownership. We support regulations that may put limits on a person's capture and use of groundwater, if such use will negatively impact adjoining owners' use of their groundwater for private wells, their water supply, or agricultural use.
- 60. Energy Production:** We support free-market solutions and the immediate removal of government barriers and direct subsidies to the production, transportation, reformulation, refining, and

distribution of energy. We oppose federally directed plans and proposals that favor renewable energy sources that may constitute a nuisance, or otherwise have a substantially negative impact on neighboring landowners, including harming property values of our neighborhoods, farms, and ranch areas.

Transportation

61. Freedom to Travel: We oppose the Biden Infrastructure and Green Energy Plan that threatens our freedom to travel, imposes a federal mileage tax, as well as Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) or other social justice policies on Florida taxpayers and drivers. We oppose anti-car measures that punish those who choose to travel alone in their own personal vehicle, and oppose any measure to impose “road diet” mandates designed to shrink auto capacity and/or intentionally clog vehicle lanes to force deference to pedestrian, bike, and mass transit options (whose users do not pay gas tax). We urge the Florida Legislature to protect drivers from these California-style, anti-driver policies in Florida.
62. Vehicle Taxes: Vehicle registration shall only be a one-time occurrence at the point of sale and shall only be based on the price actually paid on the vehicle or trailer. Only commercial vehicles should be required to obtain a state safety inspection.
63. Toll Roads: We believe that tolls should come off the road when the debt is retired, and if the debt is ever restructured or refinanced, the pay-off date needs to remain the same.

Public-private partnerships, toll authorities, and construction:

- a. We oppose public-private partnerships, specifically regarding toll projects.
- b. We oppose conversion of existing roads or lanes to toll roads.
- c. We oppose the use of taxpayer money to subsidize any toll projects, and we call upon lawmakers to adequately fund our highways without hidden taxes, tolls, or raiding of emergency funds.

Toll administration and collections:

- a. We urge the Legislature to pass a uniform toll collection and billing procedure that prohibits excessive fines and fees, along with other pro-taxpayer reforms such as requiring agencies to:
 - i. send out accurate bills prior to adding fines and fees.
 - ii. immediately notify drivers if a payment card is not working.
 - iii. allow payment plans to be set up prior to being put into collections.
 - b. We call upon the Legislature to pass legislation to decriminalize the failure to pay tolls.
64. High Speed Rail: Taxpayer money shall not fund or subsidize high speed rail, nor shall eminent domain be used in the construction of high-speed rail.

COVID Response

65. COVID-19 Liability: Businesses shall not be held liable for any customer who frequents their business and later is confirmed to test positive for COVID-19.
66. Jobs Are Essential: We urge the Florida State Legislature to adopt legislation that recognizes and establishes all businesses and jobs as essential and a fundamental right. Governments do not have the authority to determine what entities are essential during an emergency.
67. Government Mandates: No government entity may require a business, via financial or legal coercion, to act as an enforcement arm of the state, such as the egregious action when local governments required businesses to enforce mask mandates or be fined or closed.

Privacy, Information Freedom, Internet

68. Doxing and Swatting: We recommend the State Legislature consider modifying existing State law to take into account the implications of doxing, which result in harm to one's person or business, and Swatting, a criminal harassment tactic of deceiving an emergency service into sending a police or emergency response team to another person's address.
69. Regulating the Internet: We oppose efforts to implement net neutrality on internet service providers.
70. Personal Data Privacy: We demand that all rights to privacy that individuals have in their homes shall be extended to all digital data via the use of strong public key encryption technologies. We call upon Florida to prohibit vendors of the State of Florida and its subdivisions from selling or sharing data captured in providing services to Floridians. We support laws limiting the ways in which internet providers, electronic applications, websites, schools, government entities, and others may access the electronic communications or documents of all Floridians.
71. Social Media Freedom: We call on our Congressional Delegation to push for reform of Section 230 of the Communications Decency Act to limit the ability of online social media platforms to censor the speech of citizens in the new digital town square, which they currently control. We encourage the Florida legislature to pursue legislation that give Florida residents the power to sue Big Tech Companies for targeting and censorship.
72. Cyber Security Self-Defense: We support "hack-backs," defined as counterattacks aimed at disabling or collecting evidence against a perpetrator, as a legitimate form of self-defense of persons and organizations in order to ensure their cyber security. The right to defend oneself in our current era must be expanded to preserve the safety, property, and livelihood of Floridians.

Finance

Spending Restraint and The Legislative Process

73. Government Spending and Taxation: We believe in the principles of constitutionally limited government based on federalist principles. To this end, we encourage our elected officials at all levels of government to work to reverse the current trend of expanding government and the growing tax and debt burdens placed on "We the People." Government spending is out of control at the federal, state, and local levels, and action is needed to reduce spending, and therefore taxation, at all levels.
74. The Legislative Process – Appropriation Bills: We believe that our legislation process with respect to appropriating money for the Federal Government is completely broken. Each year Congress is required to pass detailed 12 appropriation bills. In recent years this process has wholly or partially been avoided using continuing resolutions or CR's. Passing ridiculous CR's avoids debate and discussion and choices as to where and how our tax dollars are spent and has expanded our deficit and our government and gives politicians cover so they cannot be held accountable for their votes. We believe passing single subject appropriation bills is the only answer to this uncontrolled spending. If Congress cannot do this, we fully support a Convention of States under Article V of the United States Constitution, restricted to proposing amendments that will impose fiscal restraints on the federal government, limit its power and jurisdiction, and impose term limits on its officials and members of Congress.
75. Impoundment: For 200 years under our system of government, it was undisputed that the President had the Constitutional power to stop unnecessary spending through what is known as Impoundment. In 1974 Congress passed the Congressional Budget and Impoundment Control Act of 1974 (CBA). The CBA dramatically limited impoundment, the power of the president to choose not to unnecessarily spend taxpayer dollars, forcing the executive branch to spend every penny of congressionally appropriated funds. We believe a new Republican President must work with

Congress to overturn the limits if CBA or challenge the Impoundment Control Act of 1974 in court. Article II of the Constitution vests the president with the inherent authority to “take Care that the Laws be faithfully executed,” which has historically been understood to mean that the President can impound funds when doing so allows him to enforce the law more effectively and efficiently. Leading constitutional scholars agree that impoundment is an inherent power of the President. The restoration of Executive Branch Impoundment power will be an effective tool in the fight against wasteful spending. We also believe bringing back Impoundment will give the President a critical tool to obliterate the Deep State, Drain the Swamp, Stave the Warmongers and get the Globalists out of our government. A policy of re-establishing Impoundment is anti-inflation, anti-Swamp, anti-Globalist and is pro-growth, pro-taxpayer, pro America and pro-freedom. We believe to Florida legislature should pass legislation giving the Florida Governor these same impoundment powers.

76. Government Pensions: The Florida Legislature shall enact new rules to begin to transition any defined benefit government pensions for public sector employees to a defined contribution retirement plan similar to a 403(b).
77. Gambling: We oppose any expansion of gambling, including legalized casino gambling. We oppose and call for a veto of any budget that relies on expansion of legalized gambling as a method of finance.
78. Truth in Taxation: We urge that taxes established for a particular purpose shall not be used for any other purpose. Tax revenue derived from gasoline taxes and all other taxes/fees on our vehicles (including vehicle sales tax) shall only be used for road construction and maintenance, and shall not be diverted to any other use, including mass transit, rail, restrictive lanes, and bicycle paths.
79. Public Posting: We support all government entities compiling and publicly posting their current debt, future obligations, financial statements, check registers, and all government contracts on their official websites.
80. Repeal Taxes: We support abolishing the following:
 - a. Inventory taxes.
 - b. Business franchise taxes.
 - c. Taxes on phone and internet services.
 - d. Affordable Care Act Home Sales Tax.
81. Let Floridians Run Florida: The Florida Legislature shall pass legislation that prohibits political subdivisions of Florida and State agencies from accepting federal funds that violate Florida law.
82. Impact Fees: We support the use of impact fees by counties, municipalities, and school districts to ensure that new growth pays for the impact on governmental services without forcing the current residents to subsidize newcomers moving in.
83. Higher Education Spending Control: We support freezing public spending on State higher education until waste and administrative costs are reduced.
84. Defund Big Government, Not the Police: Any large city or county that cuts its police budget by more than 10% should be required to cut its property tax revenue by the same or greater percentage.
85. Management Districts: We oppose the creation of management or special purpose districts with the authority to impose taxes and bonded debt, and we oppose the use of eminent domain by these districts.
86. Bonds Create Bondage: We urge the Florida Legislature to amend the Florida Election Code to require bond issues be approved by a 2/3 majority of those voting and only if 20% of all registered voters in the district cast ballots. Taxpayer standing must be established to allow taxpayers to hold government entities accountable.

87. Administrative Bloat Is Not Transformative: We call on Florida school administrators to deliver more education for our dollars, instead of nonstop lobbying for more dollars for education. At a minimum, 65% of revenue should be spent in the classroom. We oppose the underhanded strategy of making cuts to visible frontline teaching positions instead of administrators and overhead.

Opposition to Market-Distorting Tax and Fiscal Subsidies

88. Bailouts and Subsidies: We encourage government to divest its ownership of all businesses that should be run in the private sector. We oppose all bailouts of and subsidies to domestic and foreign government entities, states, and for all businesses, public and private.
89. Bank Bailouts: We believe Joe Biden and his policies have ruined the American economy. His massive tax hikes, his anti-energy crusade, and his trillions of dollars in wasteful spending, have caused the highest inflation in almost half a century. As a result, interest rates soared to crushing levels. And now we're seeing bank failures that nobody believed even possible just two years ago. As a matter of National policy, we believe there should be no bank bailouts and our Nations focus should and must be on reducing wasteful spending, slashing regulations, unleashing energy production, repealing Biden's tax hikes to get inflation down as fast as possible so interest rates can get back under control.
90. Eliminate Federal Activity: We call upon the Federal Government to stop the following:
- Community Reinvestment Act.
 - Funding for the Corporation for Public Broadcasting.
 - Ownership of or insurance related to Federal National Mortgage Association (Fannie Mae), Federal Home Loan Mortgage Corporation (Freddie Mac), and SLM Corporation (Sallie Mae).
91. Pro Stadiums: Tax dollars shall not be used to fund the building of stadiums for professional or semi-professional sports teams. (discuss)

Transparency and Oversight

92. End the Fed: We support abolishing the Federal Reserve. Until that is accomplished, we support additional accountability and transparency for the Federal Reserve System, including regular financial and performance audits by qualified third parties. We support informing and educating all citizens in this country as to who directly and or indirectly owns and controls the Federal Reserve (the US central bank) and all other significant Central Banks throughout the world today.
93. Right to Use Cash and Cash Substitutes: We support adding the following protection to the Florida Bill of Rights: The right of the people to own, hold, and use a mutually agreed upon medium of exchange, including cash, coin, bullion, digital currency, or scrip, when trading and contracting for goods and services shall not be infringed. No government shall prohibit or encumber the ownership or holding of any form or amount of money or other currency. This amendment shall not be construed to restrain the State of Florida from choosing the mediums of exchange it will accept or reject in payments to it.

Education

Ten Conservative Principles For Great Schools Leading To Great Jobs

94. The United States spends more money on education than any other country in the world. And yet we get poor outcomes. Internationally we are at the bottom of every list. American society pours more than a trillion dollars a year into public education systems. Rather than indoctrinating young people with inappropriate racial, sexual, and political material our schools must change and be totally refocused to prepare our children to succeed in the world of work, and in life and the world of keeping our country strong, so they can grow up to be happy, prosperous, and independent citizens. We believe these are the ten key conservative principles that we must work on that will power our

movement to great schools.

- 1) We will respect the right of parents to control the education of their children.
- 2) We will empower parents and local school boards to hire and reward great teachers, and to fire poor ones.
- 3) We will ensure our classrooms are focused not on political indoctrination, but on teaching the knowledge and skills needed to succeed – reading, writing, math, sciences, history and other useful subjects.
- 4) We will teach our students to love their country.
- 5) We will support bringing back prayer to our schools.
- 6) We will ensure we achieve schools that are safe, secure and drug free with immediate expulsion of any student who harms a teacher or another student.
- 7) We will support school choice and we will give parents the right to choose another school for their children.
- 8) We will ensure students have access to project-based learning experiences inside the classroom to help train them for meaningful work outside the classroom.
- 9) We will strive to give all students access to internships and work experience that can set them on a path to their first job.
- 10) We will ensure that all public schools provide excellent jobs and career counseling so that high school and college students can get a head start on jobs and careers best suited for their God-given talents.

Plan to Save American Education and Give Back Power to Parents

- 95.** We believe we must take back control from the Radical Left maniacs indoctrinating our children, and give our kids the high quality, pro-American education they deserve. To do this we must:
- 1) Cut federal funding for any school or program pushing Critical Race Theory, gender ideology, or other inappropriate racial, sexual, or political content on our children.
 - 2) Direct the Departments of Justice and Education to open civil rights investigations into any school district that engages in race-based discrimination, including discrimination against Asian Americans.
 - 3) Because the Marxism being taught in schools is aggressively hostile to Judeo-Christian teachings, aggressively pursue violations of the Establishment Clause and Free Exercise Clause of the Constitution
 - 4) Find and remove radicals who have infiltrated the federal Department of Education and get Congress to reaffirm the president's ability to remove recalcitrant employees from the job.
 - 5) Stop the sinister effort to weaponize civics education.
 - 6) Keep men out of women's sports.
 - 7) Create a new credentialing body to certify teachers who embrace patriotic values and understand that their job is not to indoctrinate children, but to educate them.
 - 8) Implement massive funding preferences and favorable treatment for all states and school districts that make the following historic reforms in education: A) Abolish teacher tenure for grades K through 12 and B) adopt Merit Pay and C) Drastically cut number of school administrators, including the "DEI" bureaucracy and D) Adopt a Parental Bill of Rights that includes complete curriculum transparency, and a form of universal school choice and E) Implement the direct election of school principals by the parents, as the ultimate form of local control.

96. School Choice: Florida families shall be empowered to choose from public, private, charter, or homeschool options for their children’s education, and the funding shall follow the student without strings attached. We also support tax credits and exemptions for education and choice within the public school system.
97. No Regulation of Homeschooling or Private School Curriculum: We oppose any attempt to regulate homeschooling or the curriculum of private or religious schools.
98. Homeschool Families: – Since the Covid 19 Virus there has been an estimated 30% increase in homeschool enrollment. We support America’s homeschool families and believe we must protect the God-given right of every parent to be the steward of their children’s education. We believe legislation should be passed to allow homeschool parents to use 529 education savings accounts to spend up to \$10,000 a year per child, completely tax-free to spend on costs associated with homeschool education and we must also work to ensure that every homeschool family is entitled to full access to the benefits available to non-homeschooled students—including participating in athletic programs, clubs, after school activities, educational trips, and more.

Parent’s Rights

99. Parents’ Rights in Education: Parents are the primary educators and disciplinarians of their children, to which all other entities are inferior. The fundamental rights of parents to make decisions regarding the upbringing and control of their children in all aspects, but especially in all aspects of the Florida education system, shall be recognized, affirmed, and protected by changes to the Florida Constitution and Florida Law. No public service entity nor its agents, district personnel, community partners, or District Board of Trustees shall infringe upon these rights.
100. Enforcement of Parental Rights: Parents need more effective mechanisms to enforce their rights in education. We support the creation of impartial ombudsmen in both general education and special education. We call on the Legislature to establish laws to allow for appeals beyond the school district when parents file grievances to protect their rights as well as a process to administer penalties to districts and their personnel who violate those rights. Enforcements must include criminal, civil, and other enforcement measures while giving the state and private citizens a right to sue outside of the local grievance process with expedited enforcement. We call for the development of a Parent’s Right to Know and Consent booklet that contains pertinent state and federal law. The federal Pupil Protection Rights Amendment and the Children’s Internet Protection Act shall be codified in Florida law, so that additional state protections for students with disabilities are included. We call for reforms to the Disciplinary Alternative Education Program (DAEP) placement to protect parents’ rights and ensure that placement is reserved only for serious offenses.
101. Sexual Education: We demand the State Legislature pass a law prohibiting the teaching of sex education, sexual health, or sexual choice or identity in any public school in any grade whatsoever or disseminating or permitting the dissemination by any party of any material regarding the same. All school districts, individual schools, or charter schools are prohibited from contracting with or making any payment to any third party for material concerning any of the above topics. Until this prohibition goes into effect, sexual education shall only utilize sexual risk avoidance programs and promote abstinence outside of marriage. Before a student may be provided with human sexuality or family planning instruction, the district must obtain the written consent of the student’s parent or guardian [Opt-In status].
102. Inappropriate and/or Harmful Content: We request that the Florida Legislature pass legislation that requires Florida schools and libraries to filter inappropriate and/or harmful content, such as pornography, for minors. Operators of adult sex entertainment businesses and venues, adult entertainment of any kind, including Drag Queen Story Hour, shall not be part of educational programming in public schools, libraries, or any other taxpayer-funded program for children. We support passage of a law more comprehensive than the existing Florida law that prohibits instruction

in sexual orientation and gender identity in public schools. We advocate for those who violate any of the above to have their educator's certification revoked and be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law where appropriate. We believe that every public library and librarians within those libraries in Florida should be barred from any sort of membership in the American Library Association (ALA).

- 103.** Healthcare in Public Schools: Legislators shall prohibit reproductive healthcare services, including counseling, referrals, and distribution of condoms and contraception through public schools. We support parents' right to choose, without penalty, which medications are administered to their minor children. We support informed consent of parents before any school-based mental health assessments or interventions are performed.
- 104.** Religious Freedom and Public Schools: We urge school administrators and officials not to infringe on Florida school students' and staffs' rights to pray and engage in religious speech, individually or in groups, on school property without government interference. We urge the Legislature to end censorship of discussion of religion in our founding documents and encourage discussing those documents, including the Bible as their basis. Students have the right to exhibit religious items on school property.
- 105.** Education Transparency: We support requiring Florida public schools to be fully transparent with parents regarding everything to which their child is or will be exposed, without exception. We require that copyright and competitive advantage are not acceptable reasons to withhold information from a parent or taxpayer.

Curriculum

- 106.** Instructional Excellence: The educational system should focus on imparting essential academic knowledge, understanding why Florida and America are exceptional and have positively contributed to our world, and while doing so, also offer enrichment subjects that bless students' lives. Curriculum of Instructional Excellence shall include the following:
- Language arts, with phonics-based reading instruction, spelling, literature, and writing.
 - Civics, which includes passing the US Citizenship and Immigration Services test.
 - Mathematics, which has correct answers and focuses on how to arrive at them.
 - Science.
 - Social Studies, including geography, economics, US and World History. Such instruction shall focus on American exceptionalism and the benefits of the free-enterprise system and includes instruction on the consistent failures of socialism and communism.
 - We support education in the arts and music and building critical thinking skills, including logic, rhetoric, and analytical sciences. We support quality vocational educational training that imparts skills needed by local employers and leads to meaningful post-graduation employment.
- 107.** Founding Documents in High School: We support a high school level curriculum (rather than 8th grade level) for the study of American history (pre-1877) that is heavily weighted toward the study of original founding documents, including the Declaration of Independence, the United States Constitution, the Constitutional Convention, the *Federalist Papers*, and Founders' writings.
- 108.** American Identity: We favor strengthening our common American identity, which includes the contribution and assimilation of diverse racial and ethnic groups. We reject Critical Race Theory as a post-Marxist ideology that seeks to undermine the system of law and order itself and to reduce individuals to their group identity alone. We support legislation to remove this ideology from government programs, including education involving race, discrimination, and racial awareness. To facilitate the appreciation of our American identity, the contrast between freedom and the tyrannical history of socialism/communism throughout history must be taught. Students shall pledge allegiance to the United States and Florida flags daily to instill patriotism. Students have the right to display patriotic items on school property. Schools shall have the options to display the National Motto "In God We Trust."

- 109. Scientific Theories: We support objective teaching of scientific theories, such as life origins and climate change. These shall be taught as challengeable scientific theories subject to change as new data is produced. Teachers and students shall discuss the strengths and weaknesses of these theories openly, without fear of retribution or discrimination of any kind.
- 110. National Core Curriculum: We oppose the use of national or international standards in the State of Florida (i.e., International Baccalaureate, Common Core, TEKS Resource System (formerly CSCOPE), United Nations Inclusion, National Sexuality Education Standards, and SIECUS, etc.) We also oppose the modification of college entrance exams to reflect any national core philosophies. Any school district that violates state law banning the use of a national core curriculum or standards shall lose all state funding until said curricula or standards are removed and no longer utilized in classrooms.
- 111. Bilingual Education: We encourage non-English-speaking students to transition, via best practices, to English within two years, allowing them to quickly assimilate and succeed in American society.
- 112. Oversight of Instructional Materials: All instructional materials paid for with state funds shall be vetted by the elected State Board of Education, and we oppose appropriation of state funds for instructional content that has not been approved by the SBOE. This approval process must continue to include public review, hearings, and the right to have factual errors corrected. We call on local districts to hold public hearings before deciding which instructional materials they will use including supplemental materials and programs.
- 113. Education on Humanity of the Preborn Child: Florida students shall learn about the Humanity of the Preborn Child, including life-affirming definitions of life and the study of life, life begins at fertilization, milestones of fetal development at two-week gestational intervals, use of fetal baby models, witnessing of a live ultrasound, viewing the *Miracle of Life* type video, and (for high school students) the contents of the Woman's Right to Know booklet.

Governance

- 114. Abolish Department of Education: Since education is not an enumerated power of the federal government, we believe the Department of Education should be abolished, and the transfer of any of its functions to any other federal agency should be prohibited.
- 115. School Security: We support passage of a statute, which permits local law enforcement to provide handgun safety and proficiency training for all educators and allows LTC (License to Carry) holders to carry a concealed firearm on the premises of Pre-K-12 schools for security and protection purposes.
- 116. School Safety: We call for mandatory reporting to law enforcement of school children who have committed violent acts on school property.
- 117. School Boards: We believe locally elected school boards have a duty to ensure that the education provided reflects traditional Florida values and have purview over policy, curriculum, and budget. We oppose micromanagement guidelines, trainings, and governance policies that empower appointed superintendents at the expense of elected school boards. We believe university regents should also play an active role in the governance of their institutions and should not rubberstamp what university chancellors and presidents propose.
- 118. Withdraw from Taxpayer-Funded Lobby Groups Like FSBA: Local independent school districts should sever all ties with taxpayer funded lobby groups including the Florida School Board Association (FSBA), the Florida Association of School Administrators (FASA), and the Florida Association of District School Superintendents (FADSS). Required and non-required training now provided by groups like the above-named organizations would instead be under the auspices of the State Board of Education, with funds appropriated for that purpose.

- 119.** Enforcement of Open Meetings: We support requiring audio or video recording of open and closed sessions and allowing taxpayers to seek limited civil penalties for school trustees who violate these open meeting requirements.
- 120.** Gender Identity in Schools: The official position of the Florida schools shall be that there are only two genders: biological male and biological female. We oppose transgender normalizing curriculum and pronoun use. We hold that biological men shall compete only against other biological men and biological women shall compete only against other biological women in athletics in the public school system of Florida and at the collegiate level.
- 121.** Plan to Protect Children: We believe in the nuclear family and that the rights of parents from being forced to allow their minor children to assume a new gender identity without the parents' consent must be protected. Specifically at the Federal and State level if applicable, we believe that:
- 1) All "gender affirming care policies" including policies giving kids puberty blockers, mutating their physical appearance, and ultimately performing surgery on minor children should be revoked.
 - 2) New executive orders instructing every federal and state agency to cease all programs that promote the concept of sex and gender transition at any age should be issued immediately.
 - 3) Congress should permanently stop federal taxpayer dollars from being used to promote or pay for these procedures.
 - 4) A Federal law should be immediately passed prohibiting child sexual mutilation in all 50 states.
 - 5) Any hospital or healthcare provider participating in the chemical or physical mutilation of minor youth will no longer meet federal health and safety standards for Medicaid and Medicare—and will be terminated from the program.
 - 6) The creation of a private right of action for victims to sue doctors who have unforgivably performed these procedures on minor children should be enacted.
 - 7) The Department of Justice must be directed to investigate Big Pharma and the big hospital networks to determine whether they have: A) Deliberately covered up horrific long-term side-effects of "sex transitions" to get rich at the expense of vulnerable patients and B) Illegally marketed hormones and puberty blockers, which are in no way licensed or approved for this use.
 - 8) The Department of Education must be directed to inform states and school districts that if any teacher or school official suggests to a child that they could be trapped in the wrong body, they will be faced with severe consequences, including, potential Civil Rights violations for sex discrimination, and the elimination of federal funding.
 - 9) As part of our new credentialing body for teachers, we will promote positive education about the nuclear family, the roles of mothers and fathers, and celebrating rather than erasing the things that make men and women different and unique. Ask Congress to pass a bill establishing that: A) The only genders recognized by the U.S. government are male and female—and they are assigned at birth. B) Title IX prohibits men from participating in women's sports and protects the rights of parents from being forced to allow their minor child to assume a new gender identity without the parents' consent.
- 122.** Foreign Charter Schools: Charter schools should have accountability and transparency to local parents, taxpayers, and the State of Florida, as do current public schools. We oppose public funding of charter schools that receive money from foreign entities. We urge the Florida Legislature to enact legislation that requires charter school operators and board members to be eligible Florida voters.

Higher Education

- 123.** We believe the time has come that we must reform higher education. For decades, tuition costs at colleges and universities have been exploding, while academics have been obsessed with indoctrinating America's youth. To reform higher education, we believe we must.
- 1) Establish the American Academy. America needs a revolution in higher education that will provide life-changing opportunities for tens of millions of Americans. In the latter part of 2023, Americans have been horrified to see students and faculty at Harvard and other once-respected universities expressing support for the savages and jihadists who attacked Israel. We spend more money on higher education than any other country, and yet they're turning our students into Communists and terrorists and sympathizers of many, many different dimensions. We cannot allow let this to continue. It is time to offer something dramatically different. We must endow a new American Academy. Its mission will be to make a truly world-class education available to every American, free of charge, and do it without adding a single dime to the federal debt. This institution will gather an entire universe of the highest quality educational content, covering the full spectrum of human knowledge and skills, and make that material available to every American citizen online for free. Whether one wants lectures in US or in ancient history or an introduction to financial accounting, or training in a skilled trade, the goal will be to deliver it and get it done properly, using study groups, mentors, industry partnerships, and the latest breakthrough in computing. This will be a top-tier education option for the people. It will be strictly non-political, and there will be no wokeness or jihadism allowed. Most importantly, the American Academy will compete directly with the existing and very costly four-year university system by granting students degree credentials that the U.S. government and all federal contractors will henceforth recognize. The Academy will award the full and complete equivalent of a bachelor's degree. In addition to help the 40 million Americans who have some college education but no degree, the American Academy will grant credit for past coursework at legacy institutions and give Americans the chance to complete your education at the American Academy for free and much more quickly than is now possible or available. The American Academy will be a revolutionary in higher education and will provide life-changing opportunities for tens of millions of Americans. To fund the American Academy, we will take the billions and billions of dollars that we will collect by taxing, fining, and suing excessively large private university endowments, and we will then use that money to endow the American Academy.
 - 2) Reform the higher education accreditation process. Accreditation standards must be changed to include defending the American tradition and Western civilization, protecting free speech, eliminating wasteful administrative positions that drive costs up significantly, removing all Marxist diversity, equity, and inclusion bureaucrats, offering options for accelerated and low-cost degrees, providing meaningful job placement and career services, and implementing college entrance and exit exams to prove that students are actually learning and getting their money's worth. Radical Left accreditors that have allowed our colleges to become dominated by Marxist Maniacs and lunatics must have their employment terminated. New accreditors who will impose real standards on colleges and universities will be hired to replace them.
 - 3) Direct the Department of Justice to pursue federal civil rights cases against schools that continue to engage in racial discrimination. Schools that persist in explicit unlawful discrimination under the guise of equity must have their endowments taxed via fines, up to the entire amount of their endowments.
 - 4) Utilize a portion of the seized funds will then be used as restitution for victims of these illegal and unjust policies, policies that hurt our country so badly
- 124.** College Tuition and Student Loan Reform: College costs are out-of-control, and reform is urgently required, including the following:
- a. We call for reasonable limits on public university tuition and student loan borrowing commensurate with fiscal responsibility and current earnings in the student's field of education.

- b. We oppose mass cancellation of student loan obligations but support tax credits and interest rate reductions to ease the burden on students deeply in debt.
- c. We support requiring universities to share the risk of guaranteeing student loans, and universities with multi-billion-dollar endowments should guarantee their own student loans.
- d. We oppose in-state tuition and financial aid for illegal aliens.
- e. We oppose Robin Hood schemes that raise tuition for some students to give to others.

125. Real Standards for Colleges and Universities: We believe real standards must be imposed on American colleges and universities. These standards must include defending the American tradition and Western civilization, protecting free speech, eliminating wasteful administrative positions that drive up costs, removing all DEI bureaucrats, offering options for accelerated and low-cost degrees, providing meaningful job placement and career services, and implementing college entrance and exit exams to prove that students are getting their money's worth.

We believe tuition costs at colleges and universities have been exploding while academics have been obsessed with indoctrinating America's youth. The time has come to reclaim our once great educational institutions from the radical Left. To do this we must overhaul the college and University accreditation system. Accreditors are supposed to ensure that schools are not ripping off students and taxpayers, but they have failed totally. A new Republican President must fire the radical Left accreditors that have allowed our colleges to become dominated by Marxists and hire new accreditors who will impose real standards on our colleges and universities once and for all. These standards must include defending the American tradition and Western civilization, protecting free speech, eliminating wasteful administrative positions that drive up costs incredibly, removing all Marxist diversity, equity, and inclusion bureaucrats, offering options for accelerated and low-cost degrees, providing meaningful job placement and career services, and implementing college entrance and exit exams to prove that students are actually learning and getting their money's worth. Furthermore, we believe a new Republican President must direct the Department of Justice to pursue federal civil rights cases against schools that continue to engage in racial discrimination. Schools that persist in explicit unlawful discrimination under the guise of equity must have their endowment taxed. A portion of the seized funds will then be used as restitution for victims of these illegal and unjust policies.

126. Fund and Support Western Civilization Instruction, Defund Political Correctness: We support the following perspectives and actions at Florida colleges, universities, and secondary schools:

- a. Like Hillsdale College, we agree that state universities "should value the merit of each unique individual, rather than succumbing to the discriminatory trend of so-called social justice and multicultural diversity, which judges individuals not as individuals, but as members of a group which pits one group against other competing groups in divisive power struggles."
- b. We oppose any state formula funding or graduation requirements for divisive curricula inconsistent with the above, including Marxist, anti-American, Critical Race Theory, multiculturalism, or diversity-equity-inclusion courses.
- c. We oppose using public funds for homosexuality, transgender, or diversity-equity-inclusion centers.
- d. Public universities should be required to create a comprehensive program of instruction in Western Civilization, American Institutions, and free-market liberty principles, with centers and funding dedicated to that task.
- e. Public universities should be required to comply with the above before tuition or state appropriations are increased.

127. Campus Speech: We urge the Florida Legislature to recognize the rights of those on college campuses to practice their faith and their right to free speech. We support withdrawal of public funding from any college or university within this state that actively or passively discriminates or permits discrimination against the free speech of either students or guest speakers. Student groups shall have the unfettered right to elect their leaders, choose their members, and set their organization's mission, purpose, and standard of conduct.

128. Tenure: We support abolishing the system of tenure in all academia and advocate replacing it with a merit-based system for teacher retention.
129. Equal Access: All Florida students shall have equal access to all state-supported university admissions, grants, scholarships, and loans, based upon measurable academic criteria. We support the suspension of federal funding from universities that prohibit military recruitment on campus.
130. Medical Students' Religious Liberty: All persons have the right of conscience and shall be protected under Florida law if they conscientiously object to participate in practices that conflict with their moral or religious beliefs. This includes, but is not limited to, abortion, including any requirement for a medical resident or physician to perform an elective abortion on an opt-out basis instead of an opt-in basis, the prescription for and dispensing of drugs with abortifacient potential, human cloning, embryonic stem cell research, eugenic screenings, genetic engineering, euthanasia, assisted suicide, harmful futile procedures, vaccines, and the withdrawal of nutrition and hydration.

Health and Human Services

Parents' Rights

131. Parental Rights and Responsibilities: We support the fundamental constitutional rights of parents to raise and educate their children, including their rights to direct the care, custody, control, upbringing, moral and religious training, and medical care of their children. Local, state, or federal laws, regulations, or policies that limit parental rights in the rearing of both biological and adopted children shall not be enacted. Parents have the God-given right and responsibility to direct and guide their children's care and moral upbringing.
132. Parental Rights of Dependent Adult Children: As long as parents are responsible for an adult child, through college or the age of 26 when children are on the parents' insurance, the parents must have access to medical information, grades, and other information normally afforded to parents of minor children.
133. Parental Consent: We insist on informed parental consent for all medical care, counseling, etc., for all minors.

Healthcare Independence

134. Medical Freedom: We call for an addition to the Florida Bill of Rights that explicitly states that Floridians have the natural, inalienable right to refuse vaccination or other medical treatment. Therefore, the following are expressly forbidden even in an emergency or in a pandemic:
 - a. Since informed consent is a basic human right, any attempt to mandate, force, or coerce any medical test, procedure, or product, including vaccines or masks.
 - b. Our personal healthcare decisions are private; any attempt to use a citizen's perceived health, infection recovery, or vaccination status as a condition to maintain or obtain housing or employment or employee benefits, attend school or childcare, or access state services.
 - c. Any school, public or private, or any health care provider withholding from a parent or legal guardian information that is relevant to the physical or mental health of the minor, to include information related to a minor's perception that his or her gender or sex is inconsistent with his or her biological sex.
 - d. Any mandates by public, private, government, or medical entities for treatment, vaccination, vaccine passports, mask requirements, health insurance surcharges, or use of controlled substances of any kind.
 - e. Any involuntary isolation or quarantine of anyone not experiencing an active contagious infection.
 - f. Any withholding of the risks and benefits of a proposed intervention, including quantifiable adverse effects must be equally communicated and accessible to the patient or to a minor patient's parents or guardian.

- g. Any prevention of visitation to the ill when risks are acknowledged and mitigated according to patient and visitor choice.
- h. Any Nuremberg Code violations—including but not limited to the requirement that use of experimental use medications must provide full knowledgeable consent and be free from any form of coercion or inducement.
- i. Any tracing of individuals by cell phones or another means for any reason without an individual court issued warrant. We ask that the Contact Tracing Program, Workforce and Center Programs agreement be rescinded.
- j. Any requirement that a nurse practitioner can only provide healthcare to Floridians under a delegation agreement with a physician in the State of Florida.
- k. Any holding of an individual against their will (or that of their parent or guardian) in a hospital or residential care facility or preventing an individual from changing their healthcare provider.

135. Florida Medical Rights and Protections: To protect the rights of both patients and physicians, the Florida Board of Medicine (FBM) should adopt the following provisions and Protections.

- a. Protect the right of patients to choose natural solutions, including chiropractic care, to their health problems, as well as the physician’s right to provide natural solutions for health problems.
- b. Protect physicians from interference from the FBM or the Florida State Board of Pharmacy in the physician’s treatment plans or prescriptions.
- c. Eliminate confidential complaints against physicians.
- d. Eliminate anonymous medical witnesses against physicians.
- e. Mandate legal due process in all FBM proceedings.
- f. Allow physicians the right to have a complaint against them tried in a state district court, rather than in an administrative law court.
- g. Prohibit FBM members from working for insurance, pharmaceutical companies, or hospitals while serving on the board, to prevent conflict of interest.
- h. Prohibit intimidation tactics by FBM lawyers against physicians.

136. Medication Manufacturing and Cost to US Consumers: Medications and prescription drugs consumed in the US should be manufactured in the US for security, consistency, and reliability of the drug. We strongly encourage our state to promote private entities to initiate and sustain the buildup of the supply chain and manufacturing of the medical and health products in this state to help reduce the costs and increase the availability of medical products to its constituents.

We believe all citizen consumers of the United States should pay no more than the best price offered to other countries for prescription drugs. For years Americans have been paying among the highest prices in the world for prescription drugs while other countries negotiate sweetheart deals off the backs of American consumers. We believe a new Republican President must sign an executive order ending this unfair practice.

137. Pharmaceutical shortages: We believe the Biden Administration’s historic and nationwide pharmaceutical shortages coupled with our dependence foreign manufacturers, especially China, for essential medicines represents a severe national and public health crisis. To combat this crisis we must do the following.

- 1) Restore President Trump’s Executive Order 13944 which would ensure essential medicines, medical countermeasures, and critical pharmaceutical inputs are made in the United States. This EO also required federal agencies to “Buy American”. Biden’s gutting of this EO to “Buy American” allows federal agencies to buy essential medicines from unsafe foreign counties.
- 2) Properly fund and re-supply the Strategic National Stockpile of Pharmaceuticals.
- 3) Utilize tariffs and import restrictions to help bring back the production of essential medicines to the United States.

These steps will stop this crisis and will create thousands of new American jobs.

138. Labels on Medications: The labels on all prescription and over-the-counter drugs, supplements, and

medical supplies must be required to show the country where manufactured or produced.

139. Medical Records and Informed Consent: We oppose any state or federal medical record computer database that stores personal identifiable records on citizens without their written consent.
140. Right to Try: We urge the Florida State Legislature and Governor to enact laws that protect patients' and their doctors' rights to have access to experimental or off-label medications and procedures that can potentially be lifesaving or improve quality of life without the Medical Board, Pharmacy Board, or Hospital Boards Interfering.
141. Healthcare Savings Accounts: All individuals shall be allowed to establish health savings accounts. Individuals shall be allowed higher annual contributions to health savings accounts.

Drug Addiction

142. Ending the Scourge of Drug Addiction in America: We believe the Biden Administrations reckless open-border policy has allowed deadly drugs to pour into our country, making it impossible to properly combat the drug overdose epidemic.

Hundreds of thousands of pounds of deadly drugs are now pouring across Biden's wide-open border and claiming the lives of over 100,000 Americans every year. Over two-thirds of these deaths involve the ultra-lethal fentanyl, which is primarily smuggled into our country through Mexico. The amount of fentanyl seized at the border more than tripled from 2020 to 2022. In the first five months 2023 alone, the border patrol seized enough fentanyl to kill 100 million people. Federal agents estimate that they are only able to seize 5 to 10 percent of all drugs being smuggled through the border from Mexico. Drug cartels and human smugglers are profiting from Biden's open border, earning \$13 billion in revenue last year—a 2,500% increase compared to 2018. Fueled by Biden's border disaster, fentanyl deaths have increased 94% since 2019, and fentanyl is now the leading cause of death for Americans ages 18 to 45.

To combat this problem, we must immediately:

- 1) Impose a full naval embargo on the drug cartels and deploy military assets to inflict maximum damage on cartel operations.
- 2) Insist on the full cooperation of neighboring governments to dismantle the trafficking and smuggling networks in our region.
- 3) Enact Federal legislation to ensure that drug dealers and human traffickers receive the death penalty.
- 4) Direct U.S. federal law enforcement to take down the gangs and organized street crime that distribute these deadly narcotics on a local level.
- 5) Permanently designate fentanyl as a federally controlled substance.
- 6) Ensure that China clamps down on the export of fentanyl's chemical precursors and if they do not they must pay a steep price.
- 7) Strengthen the pillars of work, faith, and family which give life meaning and hope for those struggling with addiction.
- 8) Make it easier for those suffering from addiction to seek treatment without losing their jobs.
- 9) Forge new public-private partnerships for companies willing to provide job opportunities and skills training to former addicts.
- 10) Expand federal support for faith-based counseling, treatment, and recovery programs.
- 11) Ensure that if a parent, child, spouse, or relative needs to take time to care for a family member fighting to overcome addiction, they can take advantage of a family leave program.

Childhood Illnesses

- 143.** Addressing the Rise of Chronic Childhood Illnesses: We believe in recent decades, there has been an unexplained and alarming growth in the prevalence of chronic illnesses and health problems, especially in children. We've seen a stunning rise in autism, auto-immune disorders, obesity, infertility, serious allergies, and respiratory challenges. Why do we not ask what is going on? Is it the food that they eat? The environment that we live in? The over-prescription of certain medications? Is it the toxins and chemicals that are present in our home. Every year, we spend hundreds of billions of dollars to treat these chronic problems rather than looking at what is causing them in the first place. We believe our public health establishment is too close to Big Pharma, big corporations, and other special interests, and they do not ask tough questions about what is happening to our children's health. We believe that if Big Pharma defrauds American patients and taxpayers or puts profits above people, they must be investigated and held accountable. To answer these unanswered questions, we must establish a special Presidential Commission of independent minds who are not bought and paid for by Big Pharma and charge them with investigating what is causing the decades-long increase in these chronic illnesses. This Presidential Commission will then publish recommendations for how every American child can have a safe and healthy childhood,

The Homeless, the Drug Addicts and the Dangerously Deranged

- 144.** Solutions for the Homeless, Drug Addicts, and Dangerously Deranged: We believe that many of our once-great cities have become unlivable, unsanitary nightmares, and have surrendered to the homeless, the drug addicted, and the violent and dangerously deranged. This surrender is making the many suffer for the whims of a deeply unwell few. To fix this problem we believe we must:
- 1) Use every tool, lever, and authority to get the homeless off our streets. There is nothing compassionate about letting these individuals live in filth and squalor rather than getting them the help that they need. Our first consideration should be the rights and safety of the hardworking, law-abiding citizens who make our society function. For a small fraction of what we spend upon Ukraine, we could take care of every homeless citizen and veteran in America.
 - 2) The Federal Government must work with states to ban urban camping. Violators of these bans will be arrested, but they will be given the option to accept treatment and services if they are willing to be rehabilitated. For those who are just temporarily down on their luck, we will work to help them quickly reintegrate into a normal life. For those who have addictions, substance abuse, and common mental health problems, we will get them into treatment. To make this all possible the Federal Government should open up large parcels of inexpensive land, bring in doctors, psychiatrists, social workers, and drug rehab specialists, and create tent cities where the homeless can be relocated and their problems identified, and they can be treated.
 - 3) Bring those who are severely mentally ill and deeply disturbed back to mental institutions where they belong with the goal of reintegrating them back into society once they are well enough to manage independent living.

Government-funded Health Programs

- 145.** Welfare Reform: We support the abolition of all federal welfare programs, as they are not an appropriate role of the federal government. Until such a time, welfare reform should encourage partnerships with faith-based institutions, community, and business organizations to assist individuals in need. We encourage welfare reform in the following areas:
- a. Denying benefits to individuals who cannot prove citizenship.
 - b. Reforming welfare programs to require recipients to work, learn, and train to move toward self-sufficiency.

- c. Reforming welfare programs to require recipients to remain substance-abuse free in exchange for temporary benefits not exceeding two years.
- d. Requiring all welfare recipients to submit to random drug testing in order to receive benefits.
- e. Requiring that money provided through the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) be used only for nutritious foods consistent with those included under the WIC program and be released only with a photo ID of the approved user.
- f. Implementing a non-monetary-based assistance program for providing supplemental food benefits.
- g. Removing prisoners from welfare rolls.

146. No Welfare or Work Permits for Illegal Aliens: We believe the Biden Department of Homeland Security is abusing its so-called parole authority to give them more governmental benefits than many law-abiding citizens, including our veterans. As a result of this catastrophic abuse of power millions of illegals will be eligible for billions and billions of dollars in welfare benefits courtesy of the American taxpayer. The Biden administration is essentially stealing American taxpayers hard-earned money to redistribute it to people who have no business being in our country.

The United States is trillions of dollars in debt, yet the radical left Democrats and RINOS are illegally dispensing public benefits such as food stamps, free healthcare, welfare checks and substantial one-time cash payments and free travel to illegals while they try to massively raise your taxes. The Biden administration is also giving illegal aliens work permits to take jobs away from American taxpayers. And then if these illegals have children, not only do the children get automatic citizenship, but they unlock a trove of additional government benefits flowing to illegal immigrant households. In the meantime, our Veterans and our citizens suffer.

As such we must stop the outrageous abuse of parole authority which like automatic citizenship for children of illegal aliens, this welfare is a gigantic magnet drawing people from all over the world to come to the United States. We must also take the necessary steps to ensure illegals are ineligible for public housing and we must terminate all work permits for illegal aliens. Finally, we must demand that Congress send a bill to a new republican President that would block any future President from abusing his power to distribute welfare benefits in this matter.

- 147.** Child Support Related to Welfare: Mothers applying for government financial support, exempting rape victims, shall provide the verifiable name and any known contact information of the birth father, which information shall be turned over to the State of Florida Attorney General's Office within 30 days for collection of child support.
- 148.** Oversight of Disability Claims: We call for stronger and more stringent reviews of disability claims to ensure that assistance is provided only to those truly in need.
- 149.** Medicaid Reform: We support Medicaid block grants to the states and returning Medicaid to its original purpose to be a temporary assistance program. We oppose any further expansion of Medicaid.
- 150.** Medicare Reform: Medicare should have a non-penalized opt-out for those who have health insurance through their employer and continue to work.
- 151.** Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act ("Obamacare"): We demand the immediate repeal of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, which we believe to be unconstitutional.
- 152.** Home and Community-Based Services: In order to avoid costly institutional care and preserve families, we call on the Florida Legislature to invest in and fully fund home and community-based services (HCBS) as a pro-life policy, and to enact associated policy solutions to protect, preserve, and defend the sanctity and dignity of human life. We urge the Legislature to address any loopholes that fail to protect or provide appropriate home and community-based supports and access to care for children and people with disabilities. In addition, we ask that families be provided with information about life-affirming social and medical services available to them in Florida as alternatives to abortion and costly institutional care.

Mental Health

- 153.** Mental Health: We support parents' right to choose or reject, with prior written informed consent and without penalty, each medication and mental health assessment or survey administered to their children.

Homosexuality and Gender Issues

- 154.** Homosexuality: Homosexuality is an abnormal lifestyle choice. We believe there should be no granting of special legal entitlements or creation of special status for homosexual behavior, regardless of state of origin, and we oppose any criminal or civil penalties against those who oppose homosexuality out of faith, conviction, or belief in traditional values. No one should be granted special legal status based on their LGBTQ+ identification.
- 155.** Gender Identity: We oppose all efforts to validate transgender identity. For the purpose of attempting to affirm a person age 21 or under if their perception is inconsistent with their biological sex, no medical practitioner or provider may engage in the following practices:
- Intervene in any way to prevent natural progression of puberty.
 - Administer or provide opposite sex hormones.
 - Perform any surgery on healthy body parts of that person.
- 156.** No Taxpayer Funding for Sex Change: We oppose the use of taxpayer funds for any type of medical gender dysphoria treatments or sex change operations and/or treatments. This includes but is not limited to military personnel as well as inmates in federal, state, or local prisons or jails. Inmates must be housed according to their biological sex. No Federal, state, insurance, or probate monies may be allocated for the use of such treatment.
- 157.** Counseling Methods: Therapists, psychologists, and counselors licensed with the State of Florida shall not be forbidden or penalized by any licensing board for practicing Reintegrative Therapy or other counseling methods when counseling clients of any age with gender dysphoria or unwanted same-sex attraction.

Substance Abuse & Addiction

- 158.** Addiction: We oppose legalization and decriminalization of illicit natural and/or illegal synthetic drugs, and we support the exercise of a zero-tolerance policy with maximum penalty for illegal drug manufacturers and distributors. We also oppose any needle exchange programs. Faith-based rehabilitation programs shall be considered as a part of an overall rehabilitation program.
- 159.** Ban on Exposing Minors to Pornography Online: We call upon our elected leaders to compel any websites displaying pornographic content in Florida to implement age verification for preventing minors from accessing the content, and to block or punish any such websites that continue to make such material available to minors.
- 160.** Pornography Crisis: The State of Florida shall recognize that pornography and pedophilia are public health hazards.

Life-Affirming Health Care Concepts

- 161.** Conscience Clause: All persons and legal entities have the right of conscience and shall be protected under Florida law if they conscientiously object to participate in practices that conflict with their moral or religious beliefs. This includes, but is not limited to, abortion, the prescription for and dispensing of drugs with abortifacient potential, human cloning, embryonic stem cell research, eugenic screenings, genetic engineering, euthanasia, assisted suicide, harmful futile procedures, vaccines, and the withdrawal of nutrition and hydration. We call on the Florida Legislature to enact additional conscience protections for all healthcare professionals, including medical students, that are all-encompassing, enforceable at the state level, and protect against adverse action and

retaliation taken against an individual. (review)

- 162.** Fetal Tissue Harvesting and Stem Cell Research: We support legislation prohibiting and criminalizing the harvesting, sale, and experimentation or commercial use of human fetal tissue, including for vaccines, which requires or is dependent upon the destruction of human life. We encourage adult stem cell research using cells from umbilical cords, from adults, and from any other means that does not kill human embryos. We also support elimination of public funding for embryonic stem cell research, research on fetal tissue, or human cloning. All products that use embryonic and fetal tissue in their production shall be labeled in the State of Florida to inform consumers, promote alternatives, and affirm the value of human life.
- 163.** Alternatives to Abortion: We urge the Republican Party of Florida to support programs that provide assistance to pregnant women by:
- a. Protecting and increasing funding to Alternatives to Abortion Program.
 - b. Ensuring women have medical insurance coverage up to one year postpartum, making it safer for pregnant women to give birth in Florida.
- Safeguarding pregnant and parenting college students from discrimination, ensuring access to educational opportunities, benefits, accommodations, and support services.
- 164.** Discriminatory Abortion: We support legislation to close existing discriminatory loopholes that fail to protect preborn children suspected of having a "fetal anomaly" or disability, and we support legislation to enact anti-discriminatory language to apply additional protections to preborn children at risk of being aborted because of their sex, race, disability, or age of gestation, in addition to providing families with information about life-affirming social and medical services available to them in Florida, such as perinatal palliative care.
- 165.** Planned Parenthood: We support eliminating public funding for, or contracts with, Planned Parenthood and any other abortion providers and all their affiliates. We oppose their digital or physical presence in our schools and other public institutions, as well as the expansion of their facilities in our neighborhoods. We call for a State law prohibiting governmental contracts with abortion providers and their affiliates.
- 166.** End-of-Life Patient Protection: We support patients' rights, especially near the end of life. Patients rights must include provisions that:
- a. Medical personnel may not deny care, change advanced directives, or originate directives for any patient without the informed consent of the patient or the patients designate.
 - b. Advance Directives are strengthened by requiring hospitals intending or threatening to withdraw life-sustaining treatment against the patient's wishes or their advance directive to continue all treatment and care for such patients pending transfer to another facility.
 - c. The discriminatory rationing of healthcare services premised on any aspect of the patient, including a patient's age, race, sex, disability, or perceived quality of life is prohibited.

Environmental

- 167.** Toxic Exposure: We support the immediate implementation of the Toxic Exposure Research Act of 2015, which will ensure that the federal government will establish a database on all exposed veterans and their families.

Criminal and Civil Justice

Rights and Protections

- 168.** The Weaponization of our Justice System: We Believe that the Corruption in and the Weaponization of our entire justice system is a dire threat to the American way of life and we must restore the fair and impartial rule of law. To do this we believe the following steps must be taken immediately.
- 1) A new Republican Administration must appoint at least 100 US Attorneys throughout the United States to wage war against crime and corruption in this country.
 - 2) The Department of Justice and FBI must be completely overhauled. We must launch sweeping civil rights investigations into Marxist local district attorneys who refuse to charge countless crimes and are engaging in selective enforcement of the law based upon illegal racial discrimination.
 - 3) The Department of Justice must establish a task force to protect our citizens rights to self-defense.
 - 4) An investigation of the use of “police state” tactics by federal authorities to arrest conservatives and Christians must be conducted immediately. These investigations will root out who ordered these tactics and those responsible will be held accountable.
 - 5) We must establish a plan and then confront the radicalization of America’s law schools, fight the purge of Conservatives at law firms and reform the far-left Bar Associations who embrace Project 65.
- 169.** Civil Asset Forfeiture: We call upon the Federal Legislature to abolish civil asset forfeiture, independently or in partnership with federal authorities, and to ensure that private property only be forfeited upon a criminal conviction.
- 170.** Government Surveillance: We oppose all forms of warrantless government surveillance of United States citizens and businesses.
- 171.** Location and Data Privacy: We call upon the Florida Legislature to protect citizens' current and historic technologically available location data by requiring a warrant based on probable cause or a legally obtained subpoena.
- 172.** Hate Crimes: We urge the complete repeal of the hate crime laws, since ample laws are currently in effect to punish criminal behavior towards other persons.
- 173.** Marriage Officiation: We believe religious institutions have the freedom to recognize and perform only those marriages that are consistent with their doctrine.
- 174.** Warrant Validity: The filers of search warrants shall be held responsible for the validity of the information used to obtain the warrants.
- 175.** Pandemic Business Fines: We support prohibiting fines or imprisonment of business owners for operating their business during pandemics, and we call for the legislature to pass these protections into law.
- 176.** Fraudulent Lien Filings: We support legislation designed to reduce fraud by requiring that the identity of the debtor on all liens be confirmed prior to filing by at least three methods, including but not necessarily limited to state ID, county records, and personal contact.
- 177.** Gain-of-Function Accountability: We call for the banning of gain-of-function research in Florida, in our country and overseas supported by federal funds which makes a naturally occurring pathogen more deadly or more infective. We support investigations and indictments of those who participate in funding, developing, introducing, or releasing gain-of-function pathogens.

Courts, Prosecutions, Restitution

178. Court Accountability: We support the right to inform the jurors of their common law power to judge law (jury nullification) as well as the evidence, and to vote on the verdict according to their conscience. Article 3, Section 2 of the Constitution defines the role of judges. We support Congress limiting the powers of the US Federal Court by invoking Article 3, Section 2, and Clause 2, by legislating exceptions and creating regulations to limit the cases for which the US Federal Court have jurisdiction. We believe district attorneys have a duty to seek justice for victims of all forms of crime and oppose policies that systematically decline to prosecute crimes.
179. Frivolous Lawsuits: We support further reform to discourage frivolous lawsuits. We oppose the abusive use of class action lawsuits and any law that allows government agencies to collect lawyer fees from the plaintiff when they win but not have to pay the plaintiff fees when they lose.
180. Bail Reform: We call upon the Florida Legislature to ensure bail in Florida is based only on a person's danger to society, risk of flight, and criminal history.
181. Victims of Human Trafficking: We call upon the Florida Legislature to amend the Code of Criminal Procedure to allow victims of human trafficking to have convictions within the previous five years for prostitution offenses set aside, if they received these convictions as a direct result of being trafficked.
182. Rule of Law Enforcement: We support rule of law and enforcement of laws, which maintain an ordered republic. We call for independent prosecutorial authority to prosecute crimes that maintain order (such as sedition, riot, official oppression, election integrity, etc.) to be delegated to a statewide officer such as the Attorney General.

Law Enforcement

183. Plan to End Crime and Restore Law and Order: We believe that since President Trump left office violent crime has skyrocketed and communities across our country have become less safe as Democrats have defunded, defamed, and dismantled police forces. To restore safety in our communities across the country we believe the following action steps must be taken.
 - 1) Enact new legislation with appropriate investment in hiring, retention, and training for police officers. Enact legislation to expand vital liability protections for America's law enforcement officers.
 - 2) Require local law enforcement agencies receiving DOJ grants to return to proven policing measures such as stop-and-frisk, strictly enforcing existing gun laws, cracking down on the open use of illegal drugs, and cooperating with ICE to arrest and deport criminal aliens.
 - 3) Direct the DOJ to open civil rights investigations into radical leftist prosecutor's officers, such as those in Chicago, Los Angeles, and San Francisco to determine whether they have illegally engaged in race-based law enforcement.
 - 4) Instruct the Department of Justice to dismantle every gang, street crew, and drug network in America. Enact federal legislation that calls for the death penalty for drug dealers and human traffickers.
 - 5) Deploy federal assets, including the National Guard, to restore law and order when local law enforcement refuses to act.
 - 6) Order the Education and Justice Departments to overhaul federal standards on disciplining minors.
 - 7) Enact concealed carry reciprocity legislation, fully secure the border, dramatically increase interior enforcement, and wage war on the drug and human trafficking cartels.

- 184. Capital Punishment: Properly applied capital punishment is legitimate and should be reasonably swift, while respecting all due process.
- 185. Police, Firefighters, and Other First Responders Appreciation: We express our gratitude and appreciation for police officers, firefighters, and other first responders. We support them in the exercise of their duties. To that end, we support proper funding for robust training programs that provide them with intensive and comprehensive physical and academic training in the classroom and on the ground. We also support funding of proper mental health care and encouragement for officers.
- 186. Mental Health Support Backup: We support trained mental health personnel backup being provided to peace officers at all hours, day and night, in order to serve the public.
- 187. Protection from Arbitrary Stops: The Florida Legislature is to enact legislation to protect Floridians from arbitrary stops, detentions, or arrests for legally carrying a firearm.
- 188. No-Knock Raids: We call upon Florida legislature to improve no-knock warrant procedures to protect law enforcement and the community.
- 189. Oppose Riots: We oppose riots, vandalism, and looting and condemn such conduct. We advocate that each and every said criminal act be dealt with immediate arrest, imprisonment, and prosecution, to the fullest extent of the law and that those who have been found guilty of causing injury or the destruction of property be held financially responsible for restitution, including the withholding of any state provided benefits/entitlements if applicable.
- 190. Political Policing: We believe that laws should be enforced uniformly, that punishment should meet the crime, and that law enforcement should never be used to target individuals for political purposes. We oppose the targeting of police officers by progressive district attorneys. We support automatic and prompt expunction of law enforcement officials' records who are found not guilty in a court of law regarding job- related actions.

Family Law

- 191. Equal Parenting: We support legislation providing for equal and consistent parenting (possession and access) for every child, when both parents are fit, willing, and able, as it is in the best interest of the child.
- 192. Child Protective Services: We support reforming or replacing Child Protective Services, and we ask for any legislation that would support due process in family court proceedings, oversight of the system, and a jury determining the outcome of any case, if requested by either party.

State Affairs

Heritage Preservation

- 193. Heritage: We call upon governmental entities to protect all symbols of our American and Floridian heritage, and therefore:
 - a. We oppose governmental action to remove the public display of the Ten Commandments or other religious symbols.
 - b. We support the Pledge Protection Act. We urge that the national motto, "In God We Trust," and the National Anthem be protected from legislative and judicial attack.
 - c. We require that penalties be established for any form of desecration of the American or Florida Flag.
 - d. We support preservation of Florida history and historical sites.
- 194. Historical Monuments: We believe that all historical war memorials, including Confederate monuments, in Florida shall be protected from future removal or defacement, and we believe that

those monuments that have been removed should be restored to their historical locations.

- 195.** Honor Our Flags: We appreciate and honor our flags and what they represent, and we strongly advocate for all public schools to display the US and Florida flags in every classroom and to begin each school day with the pledges to both.

Individual Rights and Freedoms

- 196.** Data Privacy Collection and Sales: We demand that the Florida legislature protect data privacy by prohibiting the collection and selling of data and the enforcement of data privacy through private right of action. Schools shall not consent to data collection of minors on behalf of parents. Schools shall protect the confidentiality of students' identifiable information and codify federal privacy law.
- 197.** Identity Theft and Data Privacy: The Florida Legislature shall be called upon to expand existing privacy laws and laws protecting identity theft by limiting the ways in which internet providers, schools, government entities both state and federal, and others may access, collect, store, and use the electronic communications, documents, metadata, and protected information of all Floridians.
- 198.** Religious Freedom for Business: We support the removal of laws and regulations that are used to force business owners and employees to violate their conscience, sincerely held beliefs, or core values. Properly defining public accommodation as understood in the Civil Rights Act of 1964 requires that we:
- a. Prohibit any change to that legal definition by any federal, state, or local law to expand government control to restrict any 1st Amendment rights.
 - b. Proscribe any law that requires any private business or individual to create or provide a custom product or service, or any kind of expressive work, or to enter into a contract or be coerced into any speech that is not their own.
- 199.** Religious Freedom of Speech and Practice: As America is "one nation under God," founded on Judeo-Christian principles, we affirm the constitutional right of all individuals to worship as they choose. We strongly believe in Religious Freedom and Freedom of Speech. Therefore, we demand:
- a. The repeal of the Johnson Amendment, which assaults the free speech of pastors and religious organizations.
 - b. Protection of the 1st Amendment rights of any citizen to practice their religion and exercise their right to free speech in the public square, as well as in religious organization affiliations.
 - c. That Florida judges and legislators uphold and defend our God-given unalienable rights of religious liberty and freedom of speech, and we oppose any effort to intimidate and prevent.
 - d. Christians and other people of faith from exercising these rights which the civil government is required, by the 1st Amendment, to protect.
 - e. Acknowledgment that the Church is a God-ordained institution with a sphere of authority separate from that of civil government, and thus the Church is not to be regulated, controlled, or taxed by any level of civil government. Nor should services or other church functions ever again be shut down or suspended by overreaching civil authorities under any pretext whatever.
- 200.** Gender Identity—Government Policy: We support enacting legislation in the State of Florida ensuring that:
- a. No government entity in the state shall be allowed to define for any private business or private entity how it must segregate its restrooms, changing facilities, or showers.
 - b. No government agency shall be allowed to require businesses to profess, espouse, or adopt specific views on sex, sexuality, gender, or gender identity. We oppose any attempt to criminalize or penalize anyone for the wrong use of pronouns.
 - c. Government agencies must guarantee that views and positions on these matters are not used as a basis to deny access to public accommodations, as defined by the Civil Rights Act of 1964, nor to deny employment, or discriminate in employment decisions, solely on the basis of

- a person's views on these matters.
- d. We recognize that gender identity disorder is a genuine and extremely rare mental health condition, and that denial of an immutable gender binary not only denies those with the condition proper mental healthcare but also leads to physically and psychologically abusive "social transitioning" as well as irreversible physical mutilation. We urge the State Legislature to pass legislation that requires adherence to sex identifications on all official documents that will be based upon biological gender, as well as legislation enacting civil penalties and fiscal compensation awarded to de-transitioners who have received "gender affirming surgery" as compensation for malpractice.

Family and Gender Issues

201. Human Sexuality: We affirm God's biblical design for marriage and sexual behavior between one biological man and one biological woman, which has proven to be the foundation for all great nations in Western civilization. We oppose homosexual marriage, regardless of state of origin. We urge the Florida Legislature to pass religious liberty protections for individuals, businesses, and government officials who believe marriage is between one man and one woman. We oppose the granting of special legal entitlements or creation of special status for sexual behavior or identity, regardless of state of origin. We oppose any criminal or civil penalties against those who oppose nontraditional sexual behavior out of faith, conviction, or belief in traditional values.
202. Protect Minors Until Age of Consent: A law shall be enacted to protect the rights of the individual until the age of consent is reached.
 - a. Prohibit sexual transition surgeries, hormonal blockers, social transitioning, or other treatments.
 - b. Protect against predatory sexual behaviors, including but not limited to "Drag Queen Story Hour."
 - c. Remove immunities or protections from school districts and personnel who participate in the sexualization of our children.
 - d. Require disclosure of the above offenses to parents or guardians.
203. Definition of Marriage: We support the definition of marriage as a God-ordained, legal, and moral covenant only between one biological man and one biological woman.
204. Adoption: We encourage the Florida Legislature to remove as many barriers to adoption as possible and to make the process less intrusive while protecting children's safety and best interests. We urge the Florida Legislature to adopt the following steps to promote adoption:
 - a. Expand community-based care—Increase partnerships with local private and nonprofit charitable organizations to create a safer and more responsive system.
 - b. Expand service options—Improve care for families of children at risk of entering foster care by providing more choice and flexibility for family preservation services outside of the current state contracted services.
 - c. End hidden foster care—Many families are threatened and coerced into giving up custody of their child without ever going to court. Florida shall protect parents' rights and end coercive agreements by limiting CPS's ability to separate families without court oversight.
 - d. Repeal anonymous reporting—False reporting of families to CPS can lead to great harm and a large waste of resources. False reporting can be prevented while increasing the accuracy of reports to CPS by eliminating the option of anonymous reporting in favor of confidentiality. Professionals who must report suspicious activity shall be trained on alternatives to filing a CPS report and permitted to refer struggling families to community service providers.

We urge communities and people of faith to promote adoption and, for those not called to adopt, to offer assistance to families that can. We believe that, in the best interests of the family and child, the State of Florida should allow children to be adopted only by married or single heterosexuals.

- 205.** Child Rights: We call on the Florida Legislature to pass legislation to protect privacy in public schools and government buildings as allowed by Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, by ensuring that multi-use facilities, including showers, changing rooms, and bathrooms, are designated for and used only by persons based on the person's biological sex.

Pro-Life Issues

- 206.** Pro-Life: Until the abolition of abortion is achieved, we support laws that restrict and regulate abortion, including but not limited to:
- a. Parental and informed consent, including the elimination of judicial bypass.
 - b. Prohibition of licensing, liability, and malpractice insurance for abortionists and abortion facilities.
 - c. Prohibition of financial kickbacks for abortion referrals.
 - d. Prohibition of late-term abortions.
 - e. Prohibition of abortions after the time an unborn child's heartbeat is detected.
 - f. Prohibition of the manufacturing and sale of abortifacients.
 - g. Elimination of causes of action for "wrongful birth."
 - h. Health insurance coverage for abortion services and abortifacients.
 - i. Criminal penalties be attached to any entity convicted of selling body parts of aborted children or, excluding the mother, of conducting an illegal abortion.
- 207.** Inviolability of Life and Fundamental Right to Life: All innocent human life must be respected and safeguarded from fertilization to natural death; therefore, the unborn, the aged, and the physically or mentally challenged have a fundamental individual right to life, which cannot be infringed. We respect the uniqueness of human life and oppose practices that corrupt human DNA, mix human and animal DNA, or other transhumanist initiatives that do not respect the sanctity and uniqueness of human life. All humans are endowed by their creator with sovereign rights of ownership of their person and DNA, regardless of any DNA modification, and claims to the contrary are invalid.

Land Use

- 208.** HOA Governance: We support legislation prohibiting HOAs from using "policies" to bypass the process of residents' voting on changes in deed restrictions. We urge the Florida Legislature to enact legislation allowing a simple majority of property owners within and subject to a homeowners' association to dissolve the association. The Florida Legislature shall enact legislation to restrict developers from controlling the Homeowners Association more than 5 years and expanding the properties included beyond contiguous property. We also call upon the Florida Legislature to amend the language of that section of the Open Meetings Act that applies to HOAs to clearly require that every HOA that charges fees to residents be required to comply with every aspect of the Florida Open Meetings Act.
- 209.** Property Rights: Property ownership and free enterprise, the foundation of our collective wealth, must not be abridged nor denied by the government. We support legislation to protect these bedrock rights. Areas of concern are: annexation, eminent domain (including foreign entities), property forfeiture, extraterritorial jurisdiction, seizure for public or private development, natural resources and conservation easements, groundwater and/or mineral rights, nationalization of lands, and the preservation of our 4th Amendment right to privacy. Property owners shall be notified of their rights regarding condemnation, annexation, or easement, and the condemner shall be required to petition a court of jurisdiction to show public necessity. Taking of property shall result in immediate compensation of fair market value to the owner. These issues shall be administered by elected officials accountable to voters.
- 210.** Eminent Domain: The use of eminent domain must exclude the seizure of private property for private economic development or increased tax revenue.

Florida Property Insurance Crisis

211. Florida has a property insurance crisis. Approximately 30 companies have either left the Florida insurance property insurance market or have gone out of business. Additional companies are reducing their exposure to the Florida market. The Florida insurance company of last resort Citizens is reaching the breaking point of exposure and has much of the high-risk exposures in Florida that have been dropped by the other companies. Below are some of the more significant issues and problems relating to Florida property insurance market.

- 1) Florida accounts for only 9 percent of the country's home insurance claims but 79 percent of its home insurance lawsuits, many of them fraudulent.
- 2) Because of the fraudulent lawsuits and the high overall claim risk in Florida, insurance companies have faced two consecutive years with net underwriting losses over \$1 billion.
- 3) Florida has lost some form of home coverage from over 30 insurance providers in the past three years.
- 4) A bad hurricane season could crush the market.

As such we urge the Governor and Florida Legislature to work expeditiously on these problems for all of the residents of Florida

State Governance

- 212.** Campaign Contribution Limits: We urge immediate repeal of all limits on campaign contributions by American citizens to the candidates or causes of their choice.
- 213.** Prosecution of Election Fraud: We must have an amendment that gives the Florida Attorney General concurrent jurisdiction to prosecute election fraud along with the county District Attorneys.
- 214.** Marijuana Remains Illegal: We oppose the legalization of recreational marijuana and offer opportunities for drug treatment before penalties for its illegal possession, use, or distribution.
- 215.** Gun Free Zone in Florida: There shall be no gun free zones in Florida.

Government and Election Integrity

Government Operations

- 216.** Sexual Harassment: We believe sexual harassment should not be tolerated. Elected and appointed officials must be held to a higher standard.
- 217.** Government Authority: We believe any government authority that has the ability to levy a tax or fee or to appraise property on the people should be accountable to those who pay the taxes via the electoral process, from the local level to the federal level.
- 218.** Federal Land Disposition: All Federal lands shall be turned over to their respective states, except for land specifically authorized in the Constitution (military bases, federal buildings, post offices).
- 219.** Tax-Funded Lobbying: We oppose using tax dollars to hire lobbyists or paying tax dollars to associations that lobby the Legislature.
- 220.** Unelected Bureaucrats: We oppose the appointment of unelected bureaucrats, and we support defunding and abolishing the departments or agencies of the Internal Revenue Service (IRS); Education; Energy; Housing and Urban Development (HUD); Commerce; Health and Human Services (HHS); Labor; Interior (specifically, the Bureau of Land Management); Transportation Security Administration (TSA); Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF); National Labor Relations Board; Food and Drug Administration (FDA); Centers for Disease Control (CDC); Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC); Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA); and

any other federal agency or department that is not authorized by the Constitution. In the interim, executive decisions by departments or agencies must be reviewed and approved by Congress before taking effect.

Elections

221. **Bond Elections:** State and local bond election ballots shall be required to include the amount of debt currently outstanding, current debt service payments, current per capita debt obligations, the amount of new debt being proposed, estimated debt service for the new debt, and estimated per capita burden being proposed. The bond issue must obtain a 2/3 affirmative vote of at least 20% of registered voters in the voting jurisdiction. No public funds are to be spent influencing a bond election. We oppose bundling of items on bond election ballots and “rolling polling” for bond and tax rate increase elections.
222. **Election Integrity:** We believe that our right to vote is sacred and all citizens should vote. We also believe in the last 40 years the integrity of our National, State and Local elections has been compromised and therefore putting our Republic and Constitutional rights severely at risk. Without free, transparent, and open elections our Country and our future as free people is at risk. Set forth below is the Election Integrity Platform as well as the actionable steps needed to restore election integrity. We must not lose sight of this vision to restore election integrity because if we do, we will never truly have free and fair elections. and soon elections will be meaningless. We believe that these 10 election integrity reforms must be enacted before the 2024 elections.
- 1) **Reform 1) Voter Registration-** The foundation of election integrity is built upon clean voter rolls. Filthy voter rolls choked for decades with imaginary, dead, illegal, duplicated, or otherwise ineligible voters are the foundation for third world “selections”. The simple fix to this decades old problem is that the voter rolls must be cleaned out and all legal voters in Florida and across the nation must re-register to vote in person with legitimate and verified photo ID’s. No serious plan to ensure election integrity if it does not call for auditing, dumping, and re-filling the Registration database. We further believe that only the Supervisor of Election and their staff in each County can register voters. No third-party including registries of motor vehicles should be permitted to register voters. All voter registrants must have a valid photo ID as well proof of residency and citizenship as part of their voter registration application. After a complete re-registration process any voter that has not voted in a five-year person must re-register.
 - 2) **Reform 2) Electronic Elections Equipment –**We believe electronic elections equipment is not transparent, is not accurate, is not accountable to we the people and the hardware, software and networks which make up these systems is vulnerable. There has been evidence found throughout the country that electronic election equipment has been compromised by foreign and domestic actors. We believe this was evident both in the 2020 and 2022 elections. If there is not voter fraud and/or errors or irregularities to be found with ballot marking devices, electronic poll books, tabulators, centralized databases and all other associated equipment why do manufacturers of electronic elections equipment, and the software used on those devices, not consent to a full review and dissection of all the equipment and software provided by all said manufacturers. As these manufacturers will never consent to this fundamental level of transparency, we believe all electronic elections equipment must be banned immediately from use in Federal, State and County elections. With the introduction of and growth of Artificial intelligence being used in all electronic systems we believe electronic voting machines represent a clear and increasing present danger to our Republic.
 - 3) **Reform 3) Voter ID with paper Ballots Only –** We presently live in a society that requires providing proper identification for flying on an airline, buying alcohol, tobacco or firearms, renting a car, traveling overseas, renting a car, driving a car but not for verifying legal participation in perhaps our most sacred process of voting. In addition to providing a proper photo voter identification at the polls, voters should receive a secure paper ballot with anti-counterfeit features to cast an easily auditable vote. Many states including Florida are

unwilling to build a process with auditable ballots. Any departure from sequentially numbered ballots is a potential superhighway for the insertion of fraudulent ballots. The simple process of not numbering ballots makes it impossible for a voter to identify their own ballot or for an auditor to match a cast ballot with the individual who reported it cast. We must therefore move to proper voter ID coupled with numbered paper ballots. Recent studies by Cause for America have shown that the use of prenumbered paper ballots is cost effective with precinct vote tabulations done as quickly as with electronic equipment.

- 4) **Reform 4) Ban Mail in Voting** – We believe mail in voting is a real pandemic that was born and grew geometrically during the “Covid Pandemic”, to force people to accept legislatures violating law and stipulating mass Mail in Voting. France banned mail in voting in 1975 when massive fraud was discovered. Mail in Voting can never be as secure as In Person Voting because this process does not require the presentation and review of a legal and valid ID, the chain of custody control is severely more difficult and unlike In Person Ballots, Mail in Ballots can be harvested and do not require a witness signature. For overseas military personnel or voters that are to disabled to get to a polling station special Mail in Ballots can be permitted but must be subject to extra scrutiny and have a witness signature and validation. -
- 5) **Reform 5) Ban Early Voting** – The first Tuesday following the first Monday in November is called “Election Day” and has been noted as such since 1854. Arguments for setting aside a single day made almost 200 years ago were to prevent fraud. Early Voting has become widespread throughout the Country and in Florida. Early voting may allow election officials or other outside bad actors to see emerging election results prior to Election Day. Knowledge of emerging results gives advance warning of how much manipulation would be required to swing an election-on-Election Day. Individuals who cannot vote on Election Day for **legitimate** medical or professional reasons will be given a window of opportunity to vote. These individual votes must also be subject to extra scrutiny.
- 6) **Reform 6) Smaller Precincts** – We believe smaller precinct sizes will make it easier for involved precinct leadership to maintain records and validate legal participation in and conduct elections all the way from the county to the state to the federal level. This simple solution will eliminate the argument we need early voting to avoid impossibly long voter lines. Smaller precincts allow precinct leaders to keep tabs on all voters, identify fraudulent registrations and addresses in the voter rolls and to even begin to canvass after an election to quickly (before reporting deadlines) identify easily provable election fraud. We believe all precincts should have 1000 registered voters or less.
- 7) **Reform 7) Ban Ballot Harvesting** – We believe ballot harvesting must be banned and all voters should be required to turn in their ballots. The gathering and turning in of ballots by someone other than the voter is the definition of ballot harvesting.
- 8) **Reform 8) Election Day must be a Holiday** – We believe Election Day should be a Holiday. Having Election Day as a holiday coupled with smaller precincts disarms nearly every other argument aimed at preventing true election integrity measures from being introduced, especially arguments that require people to put in the actual effort to turn out and vote and by showing up it would prove beyond a shadow of a doubt that they are indeed the individual checking in to vote.
- 9) **Reform 9) New Reporting Requirements for Transparency** – We believe confidence in our system of elections is nearly as important as the results themselves. The practice of counting votes for days and potentially from only select counties and seeing the voting results invert over an extended period of time, erodes trust and belief that our elections reflect the will of the electorate. All counties must be held to the same transparency standards if we are to have free and fair world class elections. The requisite new reporting requirements for transparency are: 1) Mail-in-ballots (limited to overseas military and legitimately disabled) must be received by 5:00 PM the day before Election Day. 2) Mail in ballots must be counted and reported first.

3) Total number of votes received must be reported within an hour of poll closure, with final numbers and results reported within 24 hours (made possible by smaller precinct sizes in item 6) above.

10) **Reform 10) Heavy Prison Sentences for All Who Commit Fraud** – We believe maximum prison sentences are required for: 1) All corrupt elections officials who compromise voter rolls, state law or election procedures. 2) All politicians who knowingly violate law and accept bribes to alter procedures governing elections. 3) All election workers who suppress, harass and intimidate voters or who deliberately obstruct the fair conduct of elections by prohibiting observers from overseeing the proceedings, throw away ballots or ballot materials, “discover voting materials or violate election laws on an as needed basis to ensure victory for a certain candidate. 4) anyone who is engaged in ballot harvesting. These laws should be governed by federal and state statute with warnings on signs like you see in airports or on planes about misconduct. We further believe that fair elections depend on the fear of God being instilled in those charged with administering one of our Country’s most sacred process.

223. Other Fair Elections Procedures: We support:

- a. Allowing, by Open Records Request, a bit-by-bit forensic imaging of all electronic devices, including servers, at Central Counting immediately before and after each election.
- b. Vigorous enforcement of all our election laws as written and oppose any laws, lawsuits, and judicial decisions that make voter fraud very difficult to deter, detect, or prosecute.
- c. The constitutional authority of state legislatures to regulate voting, including disenfranchisement of convicted felons.
- d. Expanding the Florida Attorney General’s staff for investigating election crimes.
- e. The ability for civil lawsuits to be filed for election fraud or failure of officials to follow the Florida Election Code.
- f. Allowing trained poll watchers from anywhere in Florida with local party or candidate approval.
- g. Creating processes that will allow rapid adjudication of election law violation disputes as they occur and before violations can be successfully perpetrated.
- h. Requiring that a list of certified deaths be provided to the Secretary of State in order for the names of deceased voters be removed from the list of registered voters, with periodic checks on the voter rolls to ensure all currently registered voters are eligible.
- i. Use any undedicated federal election funds received to improve the security of voter registration data.

224. Campaigning at Poll Sites: We encourage free speech at polling sites outside of the existing boundaries. The right to campaign, including the display of signage, with respect to current State law, at an appropriate distance (100 feet) from the polling place, shall not be infringed.

225. Voting Rights: We support equal suffrage for all United States citizens of voting age. We oppose any identification of citizens by race, origin, creed, sexuality, or lifestyle choices, and oppose use of any such identification for purposes of creating voting districts. We urge that the Voting Rights Act of 1965, codified and updated in 1973, be repealed and not reauthorized.

226. Closed Primary: We support protecting the integrity of the Republican Primary Election by requiring a closed primary system in Florida. While we welcome people to join the Republican Party who support limited government and traditional values, we oppose campaigns to get liberal Democrats to cross over and move the Republican Party to the left in the Primary.

227. Redistricting: We support drawing districts based on eligible voters, not pure population. We believe districts should be geographically compact when possible. We oppose any redistricting map that is unfair to conservative candidates in the Primary or the General Election.

228. Republican Party Operations: We support the election of Republican County Chairs by their respective County Executive Committees where they exist.

229. Brevard School Board Elections: We believe school board elections should be partisan with

candidates bearing their Party Affiliation. We believe legislation should be enacted at the State level to enable partisan school board elections.

230. Brevard Judiciary Elections: We believe judiciary elections should be partisan with candidates bearing their Party Affiliation. We believe legislation should be enacted at the State level to enable partisan judiciary elections.
231. Campaigning at Poll Sites: We encourage free speech at polling sites outside of the existing boundaries. The right to campaign, including the display of signage, with respect to current State law, at an appropriate distance (100 feet) from the polling place, shall not be infringed.
232. Voting Rights: We support equal suffrage for all United States citizens of voting age. We oppose any identification of citizens by race, origin, creed, sexuality, or lifestyle choices, and oppose use of any such identification for purposes of creating voting districts. 235. Republican Party Operations: We support the election of Republican County Chairs by their respective County Executive Committees where they exist.

National Defense and Foreign Affairs

236. Support of Our Armed Forces: The men and women who wear our country's uniform, whether on active duty or in the Reserves or the National Guard are the most important assets in our military arsenal. All current and prior military personnel and their families must have the benefits, healthcare, housing, education, and overall support they need. Injured military personnel deserve the best medical, mental health, and rehabilitative care our country has to offer. Veterans Administration monetary benefits shall match present national price index value in all programs.
237. Rebuilding America's Military: In three short years Joe Biden has recklessly decimated America's armed forces. His unnecessary war in Ukraine, his foreign policy that puts America last, and his woke military policies and military political purges, including his forced vaccination of all military personal, has weakened our military and ruined our once great military recruitment capability.

As a result, we believe we must:

- a. Restore President Trump's America first foreign policy, end the senseless war in the Ukraine, adopt a policy that the Ukraine cannot be admitted into NATO and bring peace and stability to Eastern Europe.
 - b. Require Europe to reimburse our country for the cost of rebuilding the military stockpiles that went to Ukraine. Our country has spent \$200 billion while Europe has spent a tiny fraction of that amount.
 - c. Restore the proud culture and honor the traditions of America's armed forces. We must eliminate all the woke policies implemented by the Biden administration.
 - d. Increase Military Funding.
238. Eliminate Illegal Immigration Magnets: Florida shall require proof of legal residency for obtaining a Florida driver license and enrolling in public school and shall require proof of citizenship for obtaining voter registration and public benefits. Florida shall require all employers to screen new hires through the free E-Verify system to prevent the hiring of illegal aliens and of anyone not legally authorized to

work in the US, and to protect jobs for American workers. No tax dollars shall be provided for social or educational programs for illegal aliens. All existing laws providing for in-state tuition and nonemergency medical care shall be rescinded. All unverifiable foreign-issued identification cards shall be legally invalid in the United States.

- 239.** Military Readiness: We support a military force of sufficient strength and readiness to deter any threat to our national sovereignty or to the safety and freedom of our citizens. We oppose gender norming in the military. Transgendered persons shall not serve in the military as a special class; no special considerations or medical treatment shall be required or offered. We are opposed to expanding Selective Service to include women.
- 240.** Cybersecurity: As foreign and domestic threats to cybersecurity evolve, the State of Florida must upgrade systems and system security to meet these threats and share threat intelligence data among levels of government. The integrity of our state and local network infrastructure must be maintained.
- 241.** Defeat Terrorism: We support an aggressive war on terrorism, including radical Islamic terrorists, which consists of cooperating with our allies and sanctioning nations that sponsor terrorists. We support the reasonable use of profiling, the prosecution of national security breaches, and the revision of laws or executive orders that erode our liberties. We call on the Federal Government to designate the Muslim Brotherhood a foreign terrorist organization, and we call on governmental agencies to avoid and suspend all activities with all radical Islamic organizations, such as the Council on American-Islamic Relations (CAIR).
- 242.** Designate Drug Cartels as Terrorist Organizations: We strongly support HR1700—Drug Cartel Terrorist Designation Act—116th Congress (2019-2020), introduced by Rep. Chip Roy, which would designate Trans-criminal Crime Organizations (TCO), identified as Drug Cartels, as Foreign Terrorist Organizations (FTO), with the intention of enhancing the policing policy related to Drug Cartels. Furthermore, we request that the State of Florida establish a Counter Terrorism Division that could enforce anti-terrorist laws to deter the trafficking of drugs and people, and any other illegal activity across our borders.
- 243.** Immigration: We demand that state and federal law enforcement officers enforce our immigration laws, implement an entry/exit tracking system for visa holders, and expedite hearings on deporting both violent and non-violent illegal immigrants and visa overstays. Chain migration and the diversity visa lottery shall be eliminated. We call for the abolition of the refugee resettlement program. Any form of amnesty with regard to immigration policy shall not be granted, including the granting of legal status to persons in the country illegally. Our legal immigration system shall be strictly merit based, and the total number of new immigrants should be limited to a level that facilitates assimilation.

Border Security and Immigration

- 244.** Border Security Funding: We expect both the Florida Legislature and the United States Congress to make a priority of allocating funds to effectively secure the border through whatever means necessary, including but not limited to barriers, a border wall, and/or fence everywhere along the border where it is feasible and useful, as well as personnel and technology over land, sea, and air. Florida shall seek repayment from the Federal Government for expenses incurred in securing the border.
- 245.** State Self-Defense: We urge the Florida Legislature to invoke Article 1, Section 10, Clause 3 of the US Constitution, also known as the “state self-defense clause,” which asserts that under an active invasion (as defined or declared by the Governor of the State or Florida Legislature), the sovereign state of Florida has the authority and duty to defend Florida citizens against “imminent Danger,” not admitting delay, by any and all appropriate measures the sovereign state defines as necessary to

defend from such assaults. We must immediately equip the Florida National Guard with the necessary tools and authority to serve and protect Florida State territories and citizens.

- 246.** Interstate Border Compact: We urge the Florida Legislature to establish effective interstate compact(s) with other states for the purpose of securing the US border and enforcing immigration laws.
- 247.** Sanctuary Cities: State and Federal funds shall be denied to any public or private entity, including but not limited to sanctuary cities, that are not compliant with immigration laws. The State shall prosecute the responsible elected officials of sanctuary cities/counties/states for obstruction of immigration laws,
- 248.** Human and Drug Traffiking Cartels: We believe Fentanyl, heroin, meth, and other lethal drugs are pouring across our wide-open border. Children are being left without parents. Families are being ripped apart. Communities are being decimated. Our neighbors and fellow citizens are having their entire worlds destroyed. Our country is being systematically POISONED from within by the drugs and by all of the other crime that's taking place. It is absolutely clear that the drug cartels are waging war on America—and it's now time for America to wage war on the drug and trafficking cartels. Biden's Open Border policies are a deadly betrayal of our nation. We believe the nation needs an aggressive plan to dismantle the criminal cartels and trafficking networks that are destroying lives and communities on both sides of the border. This plan must include the following.
- a. Restore all Trump border policies and fully secure border.
 - b. Deploy all necessary military assets, including the U.S. Navy, to impose a full naval embargo on the cartels, to ensure they cannot use our region's waters to traffic illicit drugs to the U.S.
 - c. Order the Department of Defense to make appropriate use of special forces, cyber warfare, and other covert and overt actions to inflict maximum damage on cartel leadership, infrastructure, and operations.
 - d. Designate the major drug cartels as foreign terrorist organizations.
 - e. Cut off the cartels' access to the global financial system.
 - f. Get full cooperation of neighboring governments to dismantle the cartels, or else fully expose the bribes and corruption that protect these criminal networks.
 - g. Ask Congress to ensure drug smugglers and traffickers can receive the Death Penalty.
- 249.** Biden Administration Open Border Policies are a Betrayal of of Nation: We believe Biden's Open Border policies are a deadly betrayal of our nation and our country is under invasion. More illegal immigrants have entered the United States in the last two years than at any time in American history. Our border is not open because of insufficient resources or legal authorities. We Believe our border is open because Joe Biden has ordered it to be open and because he has broken the law and torn it into shreds. As such we believe we must not allow any form of amnesty now as this would be a catastrophe. Amnesty rewards the Biden Administrations' lawlessness, it rewards the cartels, and it rewards everyone who has broken the laws of our nation. We must also demand a total ban on the Biden Administration using taxpayer dollars to free illegal aliens and criminal penalties for administrative noncompliance. These Open Border policies have flooded our country with illegal aliens and illegal drugs, have promoted and encouraged human trafficking and have led to thousands of lost lives, children without parents and has ripped families apart. As such we believe that Joesph Biden, Merrick Garland and Alejandro Nicholas Mayorkas should be impeached for not protecting our borders and treason and tried for crimes against humanity.
- 250.** Border Security and Immigration: We urge the implementation of state and federal laws to require that:
- 1) Biometric identity of suspected illegal aliens be compared with a database of biometric identities of current and past suspected illegal aliens before further processing.
 - 2) A suspected illegal alien whose biometric identity matches biometric identity captured for a prior attempt at illegal entry shall remain in custody and the case expedited as a probable

attempt at second or subsequent illegal reentry.

- 3) No suspected illegal aliens can be transported across state lines until final determination of immigration status.
- 4) Additional court resources shall be made available to expedite final determination of immigration status.
- 5) Suspected illegal aliens of any age must remain in custody until final determination of their immigration status.
- 6) Suspected illegal aliens whose final immigration status does not make them known legal residents to the US shall immediately be deported and shall remain in custody until physically removed from the US.
- 7) There shall be no suspected illegal aliens released into the general US public, either directly or indirectly.
- 8) Only persons known to be legal entrants shall be released into the US population.

- 251.** Implement 287(g) Program: The Florida Legislature should prioritize legislation to incentivize and encourage the expansion throughout the state of the US Immigration and Nationality Act, Section 287(g) program, which allows local law enforcement officials to cooperate with federal immigration agents.
- 252.** H-1B Visas: We call for the permanent end of the H-1B Foreign Worker Visa program in the interest of protecting American jobs, classified technology, and national security.
- 253.** Aiding and Abetting Illegal Immigrants: We support revoking the 501(c)(3) tax exempt status of any organization that breaks state or federal law by knowingly aiding and abetting illegal immigrants. We support disbaring attorneys who knowingly aid and abet illegal immigrants.
- 254.** Florida National Guard Deployment: Congress shall not abdicate the war powers to the executive branch except when under imminent threat, and these powers are not to be used as a preemptive strike unless approved by Congress. The Florida National Guard should only be deployed to overseas combat zones under authorization of Congress through a declaration of war.

Foreign Affairs

- 255.** No RFIs from Bad Actors: The Office of Economic Development and Tourism does not accept requests for information (RFIs) from companies from those countries that have a poor human rights record and proven corruption, from communist countries, or from those countries sanctioned by the US Government.
- 256.** Trade Plan to Protect American Workers: Trade deficits under the Biden Administration have risen to the highest levels in our country's history, devastating American workers and businesses. Trade deficits are destroying our National Security. We must return to an America First Trade Policy and Platform that will bolster American manufacturing and help American jobs and businesses come roaring back to life. To combat this problem which is destroying American Jobs and enriching the Chinese Communist Party and other nations we believe we must immediately do the following:
- 1) Adopt President Trump's new Strategic National Manufacturing Initiative
 - 2) Impose universal baseline tariffs on most foreign products and raise them if a foreign country engages in unfair trade practices.
 - 3) Eliminate unfair trade deals and negotiate better deals for American workers and our Country.
 - 4) Enact and implement a bold series of trade reforms to eliminate dependence on China in all critical areas relating to our National Security, including by prohibiting federal contracts to any American company that outsources to China.

257. Fair and Reciprocal Trade: Between 1816 and 1947 America historically imposed tariffs on over 95 of all imports, with an average tariff of 37% as America ascended to an economic superpower. For decades, the U.S. government received over 80% of its revenue through tariffs on foreign goods, instead of taxes on Americans. Today however, U.S. tariffs are now among the lowest in the world, making America the most import-pressured country in the world. The current China tariff average is 341% higher than the United States, and the European Union tariff average is 50% higher than the U.S. Today the world average tariff rate is more than twice that of the U.S. We believe these unfair and unbalanced trade policies have hurt American businesses which cannot compete against their tariff-protected foreign rivals. The result has been a decrease in demand for U.S. domestic production, leading to a loss of manufacturing jobs and lower wages for our citizens. As a result of these unfair trade practices a new Republican President must establish Fair and Reciprocal Trade policies. Rather than raising taxes on American producers, we must impose tariffs on foreign producers through a system of universal baseline tariffs on most imported goods. Higher tariffs must increase incrementally if other countries manipulate their currency or otherwise engage in unfair trading practices. As tariffs on foreign countries go up, taxes on American workers, families, and businesses can come down. Raising tariffs on foreign producers while lowering taxes for domestic producers will help keep jobs and wealth in the United States. Higher tariffs create millions of new jobs, increase real household income, boost GDP, increase domestic manufacturing output, and generate hundreds of billions of dollars in new government revenue. Finally, as China continues to undermine American national security interests at home and around the world, we must revoke China's most favored nation trade status. President Trump's proposed universal baseline tariffs will restore a level playing field for American businesses worldwide.

258. Ukraine War De-escalation and Preventing WWII – We believe that the conflict in Ukraine should be immediately de-escalated, and we call for peace. This conflict is dangerous, explosive, expensive and is escalating every day. As such we must:

- 1) Stop funding this war immediately and stop selling military equipment directly or indirectly to Ukraine. Our taxpayer monies would be better spent at home rather than in another endless war that we have no real national interest in.
- 2) Immediately withdraw all American military personnel and contractors from the Ukraine theatre.
- 3) Call for the Biden Administration to stop its endless and damaging rhetoric.
- 4) Have a complete commitment to dismantling the entire globalist neo-con establishment that is perpetually dragging us into endless wars, pretending to fight for freedom and democracy abroad, while they turn us into a third-world country and a third-world dictatorship right here at home.
- 5) We must completely overhaul The State Department, the defense bureaucracy, the intelligence services, and all reconstituted by firing the Deep Staters. We must put America First.”
- 6) We must finish the process of reevaluating NATO's purpose and NATO's mission. Our foreign policy establishment keeps trying to pull the world into conflict with a nuclear-armed Russia based on the lie that Russia represents our greatest threat. We believe the greatest threat to Western Civilization today is not Russia and probably, more than anything else, ourselves and some of the horrible, U.S.A. hating people that represent us. It's the abolition of our national borders. It's the failure to police our own cities. It's the destruction of the rule of law from within. It's the collapse of the nuclear family and fertility rates. It's the Marxists who would have us become a Godless nation worshipping at the altar of race, and gender, and environment. And it's the globalist class that has made us totally dependent on China and other foreign countries that basically hate us. These globalists want to squander all of America's strength, blood and treasure, chasing monsters and phantoms overseas—while keeping us distracted from the havoc they're creating right here at home. These forces are

doing more damage to America than Russia and China could ever have dreamed. Evicting the sick and corrupt establishment is the monumental task we must all embrace and commit ourselves to.

- 7) Immediately investigate the nature, activities and purpose of the forty plus biolabs sponsored by the United States in the Ukraine. We believe special inspector general should be tasked and funded for this purpose.
- 8) We believe the American people deserve and are entitled to detailed and immediate accounting of all foreign and military aid made directly and indirectly to the Ukraine in the last two years.

259. Trade with China: We support a re-examination of our trading relationship with China based on America's economic and foreign policy interests. America should not be dependent on a communist country for critical medical or technological resources, including prescription drugs such as penicillin. Critical infrastructure such as internet or cabling, electrical or power, or water facilities should not be owned by Chinese or communist companies.

260. People's Republic of China Aggression: China's aggression in the South China Sea endangers international trade routes and infringes on allied nations' sovereignty. The cybersecurity threat posed by China continues to grow. We support the people of Hong Kong in their quest for freedom and democracy and call for China to honor its agreements with the United Kingdom.

We believe it is a clear and present danger that Chinese Communist Party has been and continues to purchase ownership stakes actively and aggressively in the critical and vital infrastructure of the United States including but not limited to energy, technology, telecommunications, farmland, natural resources, medical supplies, and other strategic national assets. By contrast the Chinese Communist Party does not permit American companies to take over any of their critical and vital infrastructure.

To protect our country and ensure our national security, we believe we must enact aggressive new restrictions on the Chinese ownership of any critical and vital infrastructure in the United States, including energy, technology, telecommunications, farmland, natural resources, medical supplies, and other strategic national assets. We must also stop all future Chinese purchases in these essential industries, and we should begin the process of forcing the Chinese to sell any current holdings that put our National Security at risk.

261. Espionage by the People's Republic of China: We believe the Chinese Communist Party continues to trample our sovereignty, illegally surveils our country and has thousands of spies that have infiltrated our country and are conducting an ever-increasing amount of espionage that has adversely effected our businesses, our financial institutions, our Universities and Colleges, and our Federal, State and local Governments in all three branches and in all major agencies.

We also believe that Joe Biden and many of our national leaders have been compromised and are controlled by the Chinese Communist Party. As such we believe that the following action steps must be taken immediately to reclaim our sovereignty and our country.

- 1) Close the borders immediately to all illegal aliens.
- 2) Retake control of our national airspace.
- 3) Immediately ban TikTok
- 4) Evaluate all Chinese Communist Party direct and indirect US holdings that may put national security at risk. Those that prevent even a reasonable risk will be forced out of the country.
- 5) Reestablish a special initiative at the Department of Justice that is adequately funded and tasked with the sole mission of targeting and eliminating Chinese espionage in the United States.
- 6) Immediately request that Congress investigate the financial operations of the University of Pennsylvania, its Chinese donors, the Biden Center and the Biden family.

- 7) Create new partnerships with businesses and universities to give them the requisite tools and transparent processes to protect them from outside Chinese and other foreign threats.
- 8) Immediately impose whatever visa sanctions and travel restrictions that are necessary to shut down Chinese access to American secrets.
- 9) Immediately identify the illegal China secret police force that operates within our country and prosecute them and or remove them from our country.

262. Foreign Policy: We believe in defending America's vital interests above all else. To do that we need Competent National Security Officials who believe in Peace through Strength. The actions necessary to insure we defend America's vital interests are as follows:

- 1) We must immediately clean house of all of the warmongers and America-Last globalists in the Deep State, the Pentagon, the State Department, and the national security industrial complex.
- 2) We must immediately stop the lobbyists and the big defense contractors from going in and pushing our senior military and national security officials toward conflict, only to reward them when they retire with lucrative jobs.

We support a foreign policy that relies on peace through strength, putting America first, providing for our national defense, and avoiding foreign deployments or entanglements. We support limited foreign aid only to America's allies who share our values. Such foreign aid must be transparent and accounted for and audited in a timely manner. We support a free-market economy, private humanitarian aid to developing countries, continued favorable treatment of proven allies, censure of adversarial entities that seek destruction of other countries, and strong policy on confronting terrorists. We strongly oppose religious or ethnic cleansing. We oppose US aid to any foreign entity that consistently votes against our interests or is openly hostile to our nation.

263. Foreign Defense: We oppose any action, military or otherwise, or any other involvement in a war that has not been declared by the US Congress.

264. Iran and North Korea: We oppose development of nuclear weapons by Iran and North Korea, and we oppose easing sanctions on either country until their hostile behavior and nuclear proliferation cease.

265. Israel: We respect Israel's rights of sovereignty, self-determination, and self-defense, and therefore we support:

- 1) The relocation of the US Embassy in Israel to Jerusalem, Israel's eternal and indivisible capital.
- 2) Israel's sovereignty over the Golan Heights.
- 3) Israel's right to exist, right to secure borders, and right to the land secured by practicing self-defense from aggressive enemies.
- 4) Prohibition of a Palestinian state within the historical borders of Israel, as it would jeopardize Israel's security and it would force Israel to give up land that God gave to the Jewish people, as referenced in Genesis.
- 5) Israel's maintaining a qualitative military edge over any and all adversaries through continued support militarily, financially, and technologically.
- 6) Prohibition of the anti-Semitic Boycott, Divestment, and Sanctions (BDS) movement as a form of warfare being waged upon Israel, on all levels, including and especially on college campuses, at the United Nations, and by anti-Western nongovernmental organizations.

266. Taiwan: We call upon the United States to move toward full diplomatic recognition of Taiwan as an independent and sovereign nation and to renew our commitment to defend our security and vital economic interests in the Western Pacific region in the face of China's military provocations, which threaten its neighbors and critical maritime trade routes.

- 267.** One World: The United States is a sovereign nation founded on the principles of freedom. We reject any assertion of authority over our nation or its citizens from foreign individuals or entities, such as the World Economic Forum, World Health Organization, and the United Nations. We reject the concept of a One World Government or The Great Reset.
- 268.** United Nations: The United Nations is a detriment to the sovereignty of the United States and other countries; because of this we support:
- a. Our withdrawal from the current United Nations.
 - b. The removal of the United Nations from United States soil.
 - c. The opposition to placement of US troops under command of the United Nations.
 - d. The rejection of all Agenda 21 and Agenda 2030 policies and programs.
 - e. The rejection of all related NGOs, councils, and environmental programs.
 - f. A zero-budget allotment of American tax dollars to any United Nations programs.
 - g. The opposition to any designation of World Heritage Sites in the United States and especially in Florida
 - h. Withdrawal from the UN Arms Trade Treaty.
 - i. Withdrawal from the corrupt World Health Organization (WHO).
 - j. Prohibition of any Global Pandemic Treaty, International Health Regulations (IHR), or amendments to IHR that would infringe on our national sovereignty.
 - k. A credible, impartial, and international investigation into the WHO's and China's actions regarding the COVID-19 pandemic.
 - l. Withdrawal from the UN International Baccalaureate Organization.
 - m. The rejection of the ratification of the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child.
 - n. The rejection of any attempt to allow the United Nations or any other foreign entity to levy taxes on the United States or its citizens.

The Unelected Administrative State

- 269.** We believe that Power must be returned to the American people by cleaning out the Deep State, firing rogue bureaucrats and career politicians, and targeting government corruption. We must also end the ongoing weaponization of the justice system that targets its political enemies simply because of their political or religious beliefs. The following steps must be immediately taken to shatter the deep state and return power to the American people:
- 1) Re-issue President Trump's 2020 Executive Order restoring the President's authority to remove rogue bureaucrats and have the new President wield that power very aggressively.
 - 2) Clean out all of the corrupt actors in our National Security and Intelligence apparatus. The departments and agencies that have been weaponized must be completely overhauled so that faceless bureaucrats will never again be able to target and persecute conservatives, Christians, or the left's political enemies.
 - 3) Totally reform FISA courts which are so corrupt that the judges seemingly do not care when they are lied to in warrant applications.
 - 4) Expose the hoaxes and abuses of power that have been tearing our country apart, by establish a Truth and Reconciliation Commission to declassify and publish all documents on Deep State spying, censorship, and corruption.
 - 5) Launch a major crackdown on government leakers who collude with the fake news to deliberately weave false narratives and to subvert our government and our democracy. When possible, press criminal charges.

Ending Veteran Homelessness in America

- 270.** Under the Biden Administration, the U.S. government has spent nearly \$1 billion to house illegal aliens and foreign migrants in expensive luxury hotels courtesy of the American taxpayer. Many

states are running out of hotel space because the rooms are all booked up with illegal aliens living in luxury on the American taxpayer's dime. Meanwhile, we have 33,000 Veterans in this country who are homeless and living in filth and squalor on our streets.

We believe a new Republican President must totally eradicate Veterans' homelessness in America. We believe he must immediately sign an Executive Order to cut off the Biden administration's massive spigot of funding for the shelter and transport of illegal aliens and redirect a portion of those savings to provide shelter and treatment for homeless American Veterans.

Ending the War on Our Suburbs

271. We believe the woke left is waging full scale war on the suburbs, and their Marxist crusade is coming for our neighborhoods, our tax dollars, our public safety, and our homes. Biden's extremist agenda to destroy America's suburbs calls for the federal government to abolish zoning for single family homes, destroy property values by building giant multifamily apartment complexes in the suburbs, and force communities to pay for low-income housing developments. This Biden power grab will put radical left-wing unelected bureaucrats in charge of micromanaging Americans' neighborhoods and communities. To combat this War on the Suburbs we must:
- 1) Repeal Biden's radical regulatory push to end the suburban way of life.
 - 2) Build new Freedom Cities on the frontier to give countless Americans a new shot at homeownership.
 - 3) Launch a special initiative to lower the cost of to build a single-family home and the cost of a new car.

Revolutionizing the American Standard of Living

272. We believe it is time to take a quantum leap to revolutionize the American standard of living. We believe our country has lost its boldness. We must restore this boldness by doing the following.
- 1) Build Freedom Cities where families and individuals can have a new shot at the American Dream. We must have a national contest to charter up to 10 new cities on a very small portion of federal land (6/10ths of 1% of all federal land) and award these charters to the best ideas and proposals for development. Freedom Cities will be built on federal land that is undeveloped and not part of any of our country's national parks or other natural treasures. These cities will give hundreds of thousands of hardworking American families a new opportunity for home ownership and the American Dream.
 - 2) Revolutionize American Transportation by racing to develop vertical takeoff and landing vehicles for families and individuals. Just as the United States led the automotive revolution in the last century, we must ensure that America, not China, leads this revolution in air mobility. These breakthroughs can transform commerce, bring a giant infusion of wealth into rural America, and connect families and our country in new ways.
 - 3) A Strategic National Manufacturing Initiative will revitalize forgotten communities by turning them into flourishing hives of industry. President Trump's America First Trade_Policy will replace the current system of punishing domestic producers and rewarding outsourcers with a new system of universal baseline tariffs that rewards domestic production while taxing foreign companies. Higher tariffs will create millions of new jobs, increase real household income, boost GDP, increase domestic manufacturing output, and generate trillions of dollars of new wealth to strengthen American society. In addition to universal baseline tariffs on most foreign goods, the Strategic National Manufacturing Initiative will reclaim our economic independence from China. We will revoke China's Most Favored Nation trade status and adopt a 4-year plan to phase out all Chinese imports of essential goods—everything from electronics to steel to pharmaceuticals – bringing many of those jobs back home.

- 4) We must work to improve our country's public spaces for the benefit of all Americans. We must challenge the governors of all 50 states to participate in a great modernization and beautification campaign which gets rid of ugly buildings, refurbishes our parks and our public spaces, makes cities and towns more livable, and works towards to creating a pristine environment.
- 5) We must also support the construction of towering monuments to our true American heroes, and to ensure that our cities are safe, we must always stand for law and order and continue to support our brave police officers.

Celebration of 250 Years of American Independence

- 273.** We believe that our country should celebrate its 250 years of independence, three years from now celebrating America's founding in 1776. We believe the following steps should be taken to make this momentous occasion a reality.
- 1) Convene a White House task force called "Salute to America 250". It will be responsible for coordinating with state and local governments to ensure not just one day of celebration, but an entire year of festivities across the nation starting on Memorial Day 2025 and continuing through July 4th, 2026.
 - 2) Engage and work with all 50 Governors to create the Great American State Fair, a unique one-year exhibition featuring pavilions from all fifty states. This Great American State Fair will showcase the glory of every state in the Union, promote pride in our history, and put forth innovative visions for America's future.
 - 3) Work with the state of IOWA to open up the legendary Iowa state fairgrounds to host the Great American State Fair and welcome millions and millions of visitors from around the world to the heartland of America for this special one-time festival.
 - 4) Enact legislation or by Presidential executive order bring back our National Garden of American Heroes and commission artists for the first one hundred statues to populate this new statuary park honoring the greatest Americans of all time.
 - 5) Invite the leaders and citizens of nations around the world to visit the United States in honor of our 250th anniversary.
 - 6) Ask America's great religious communities to pray for our nation and our people as we prepare for this momentous occasion. From the very beginning, America has been a country sustained and strengthened by prayer and by our communities of faith. As we chart a course toward the next 250 years, let us come together and rededicate ourselves as one nation under God.

Ending Citizenship for Children of Illegals and Outlawing Birth Tourism

- 274.** We believe the Biden Administration has launched an illegal foreign invasion of our country allowing a record number of illegal aliens to storm across our borders. These millions of illegal border crossers have entered the country unlawfully and all of their future children will become automatic U.S. citizens. We cannot accept this. These children will be eligible for welfare, taxpayer-funded healthcare, the right to vote, chain migration, and countless other government benefits, many of which will also benefit their illegal alien parents. This policy is a reward for breaking the laws of the United States and is a magnet, helping draw the flood of illegals across our border. These illegal aliens come from mental institutions, and they come from jails. The United States is one of the only countries in the world that says that even if neither parent is a citizen nor even lawfully in the country, their future children are automatic citizens the moment the parents' trespass onto our soil. As we must end giving citizenship to children of illegal aliens. To do this we must.

- 1) By legislation or by executive order we must make it clear to federal agencies that under the correct interpretation of the law, going forward, is that the future children of illegal aliens will not receive automatic U.S. citizenship. This policy will choke off a major incentive for continued illegal immigration, deter more migrants from coming, and encourage many of the aliens the Biden Administration has unlawfully let into our country to go back to their home countries.
- 2) End the unfair practice known as birth tourism, where hundreds of thousands of people from all over the planet squat in hotels for their last few weeks of pregnancy to obtain US citizenship illegitimately and illegally for the child, often to later exploit chain migration to jump the line and get green cards for themselves and their family members.

Republican National Committee and Republican Party of Florida Reforms

- 275.** We believe that all registered Republican Voters in our nation would be better served if certain reforms and or changes were made to both the Republican National Committee and the Republican Party of Florida. We believe that to often our elected Republican officials within the Party do not vote or act in a way that the vast majority of their constituency and/or precinct committeemen and committeewomen wishes them vote or act. Rather they vote or act in a way that benefits them personally or benefits their establishment donor class or base. Recent examples of this are as follows. 1) The recent voting in Florida and nationally for the RNC Chair 2) The RNC's lack of focus on election reforms and a plan to win elections in key swing states. 3) No meaningful election integrity reform pushed by RPOF in Florida since the 2020 elections. In summary we believe the Republican Party (RNC and RPOF) should cater to its overwhelming MAGA constituency and not to its minority donor-controlled establishment base. We therefore believe the following reforms are necessary.
- 1) RNC Elections – In Florida when RNC leadership elections occur we believe that a Precinct Committeeman and Committeewoman vote should be taken in each county to see which candidate has the most support. We believe the winning candidate for that county should be reported to the RPOF. Upon the receipt of every county's winning candidate we believe that the candidate that received the most winning votes in Florida's 67 counties should be tallied and reported back to all the counties in Florida. That winning candidate must also be required to be supported by the RPOF Chair and the national precinct Committeeman and Committeewoman from Florida in the RNC chair vote. We believe a similar procedure should be adopted by every state in our country.
 - 2) Election Integrity Reform – We believe that the RPOF should determine and outline a detailed platform for election reform. Every county's Republican Executive Committee (all Precinct committeemen and Precinct committeewomen) must vote on the adequacy of the proposed election reform platform. The vote would be either adequate or inadequate. If a county votes inadequate that County must propose and vote on modifications that would make the platform acceptable to them. The results of this vote should be reported back to all counties. The detailed RPOF platform for election integrity must continue to evolve until 45 counties vote that that platform is adequate. This process will ensure that We the People and all registered republicans have a say in election integrity reform.
 - 3) RNC Plan to Win Elections in Swing States – We believe that the RNC has historically been unprepared and does not have a viable and transparent plan to win in Swing States in 2024. The results of the 2020 and 2022 elections are clear evidence of this. The RNC was not prepared for Lawfare, was not prepared to man and watch every precinct voting place and was asleep at the wheel and did not fight or engage in stopping all the illegal voting changes made because of Covid. We must have a plan for Arizona, Pennsylvania, Georgia, Michigan, Wisconsin, Nevada, New Hampshire to win Presidential, Senate, House and Gubernatorial races. We believe the RNC must

communicate these specific plans including resources allocated to every State and County Chair in the Country.

- 4) Lawfare – We believe the RNC must build its own national army of attorneys that are capable of combating and engaging in lawfare and protecting our voting rights and all of the peoples God given rights under the Constitution. There are too many examples of the RNC using law firms and attorneys that are beholdng to or controlled by globalists, foreign entities, corporate donors, the uni-party or even the Democratic party itself. We must have an army of attorneys beholdng only to Republican voters' interests and to uphold the Constitution.

Artificial Intelligence

276. Artificial Intelligence (AI) – AI refers to the ability of a computer or machine to mimic or simulate human- like intelligence like problem solving, decision making and learning. Each Day AI systems become more intelligent, powerful, life changing and capable. AI involves the use of advanced mathematical and computational methodologies and mathematical algorithms to process voluminous amounts of information and data to make predictions or decisions based upon that information or data. AI has the potential to solve many of society's most difficult problems and issues. Despite this potential to transform society we believe AI has the potential to many catastrophic and unacceptable risks by bad actors including individuals, corporations, political parties, other countries and even our government itself. Many scientists, CEO's and technology experts believe that it is theoretically possible for AI to cause human extinction. Here the risk is posed not by humans but by self-improving AI training other AI. Some examples of the risks of misuse of AI by bad actors are as follows:

- 1) Hyper-powered disinformation campaigns on a massive scale
- 2) Devastating cyber attacks
- 3) The weakening of American democratic systems and elections.
- 4) The disruption of our military's capability and response structure
- 5) A stock or bond market crash or disruption
- 6) A significant financial system disruption
- 7) Large scale power disruptions and outages
- 8) The creation of a bioweapon that causes a massive loss of life.
- 9) The creation of powerful weapons and technologies that threaten humanity itself.
- 10) The loss of privacy and freedom of speech

Other concerns raised by many include A) AI eliminating millions of jobs in the transportation, customer service and manufacturing and health care sectors leading to whole classes of people finding themselves unemployed resulting in huge financial disruptions and social unrest. B) Reliance on AI for Childcare and Companionship. This is concerning for Children because AI rather will have an inordinate unmonitored adverse influence on our children's development and as a result also the nuclear family. This is concerning for adults as they could potentially lose focus with the real world, and a loss of human connections with their friends and family.

We therefore believe that mitigating the risks of AI including the risk of human extinction must be a US and global priority. These global risks are as important as pandemic and nuclear war risk as no specific legislation or regulations exist presently for AI, we believe dealing with these threats demands a strategic and forward-thinking approach to AI regulation. As such we believe the following steps must be considered.

- 1) Control and Governance of Computation – Computation drives AI innovation and advancement. The more computational power an innovator has the more potent and important his AI systems will be.

Advanced AI model training systems demand extensive computation which often relies on graphics processing units or other specialized chips. Limiting access to advanced chips or restricting bulk purchases of standard ones can stop or impede AI development. Regulating computing power allows a defense against the risk of bad actors gaining access to substantial computational resources and unleashing powerful AI system technologies for bad actor purposes. Hardware chips presently is the only component of AI development the government can reasonably control and regulate. Data and algorithms cannot be controlled because they can be transmitted and stored in ways that are undetectable by government monitoring systems. Algorithms are easily replicated and shared but only one user can utilize a specific chip at a particular moment in time. AI chips are trackable and manageable and can and must be monitored and controlled. As only a few manufacturers (like Nvidia, AMD, Intel, Alphabet, AWS, IBM, SambaNova, Cerebras, Groq and Mythic) dominate the complex AI global chip production process we believe that safety benchmarks for detailed AI chip Imports and Exports can be established and monitored. We must have these controls as a hedge to manage the potential destructive powers of neural networks.

- 2) AI Chip Manufacturer Acquisitions – We must find to check acquisitions of high-performance AI chip manufacturers.
- 3) We must restrict the export of advanced chip manufacturing equipment to Countries like China, Iran, Russia, and North Korea and to any identified bad actor corporations and individuals.
- 4) To stop a potentially rogue upper intelligent AI system that is disrupting our country, our financial markets, or our communications or supply chains we believe strategies should be developed to A) shut down the AI's power source, B) disrupt the AI system's communication networks so that the AI network cannot access the information and resources it needs to operate, C) override the AI system's decision-making process and D) physically destruction of the AI system as a last resort.
